

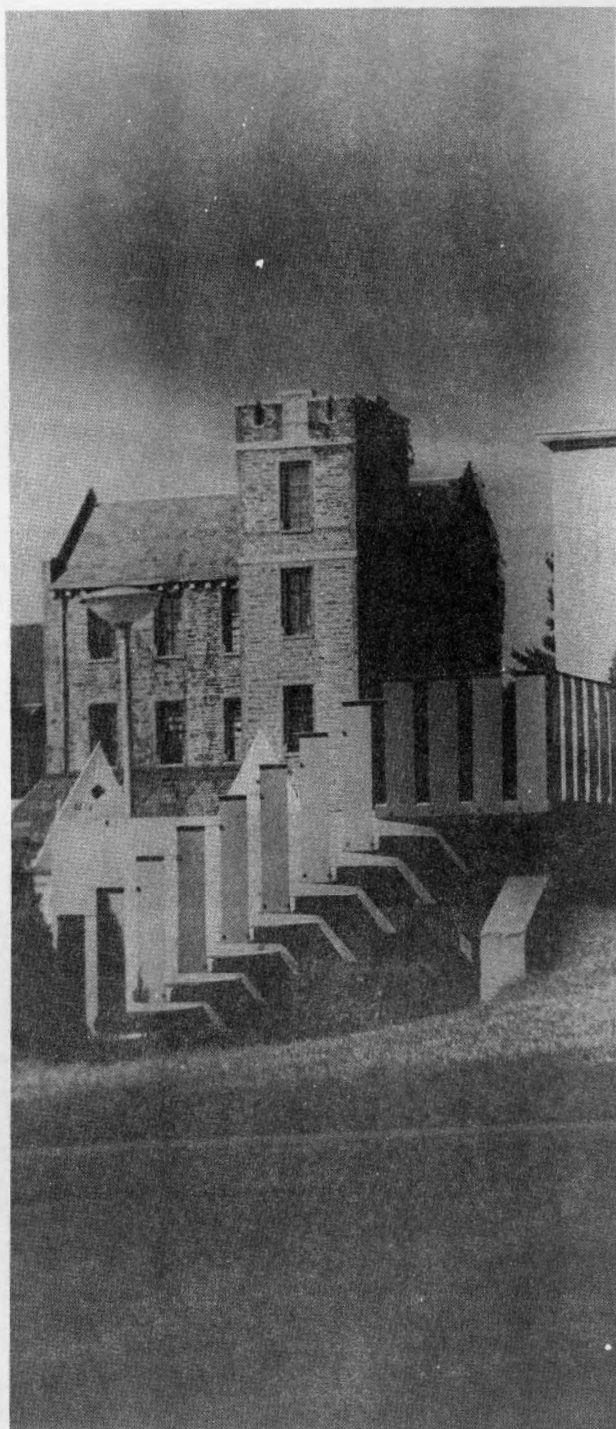

But, upon further observation, we find that we possess

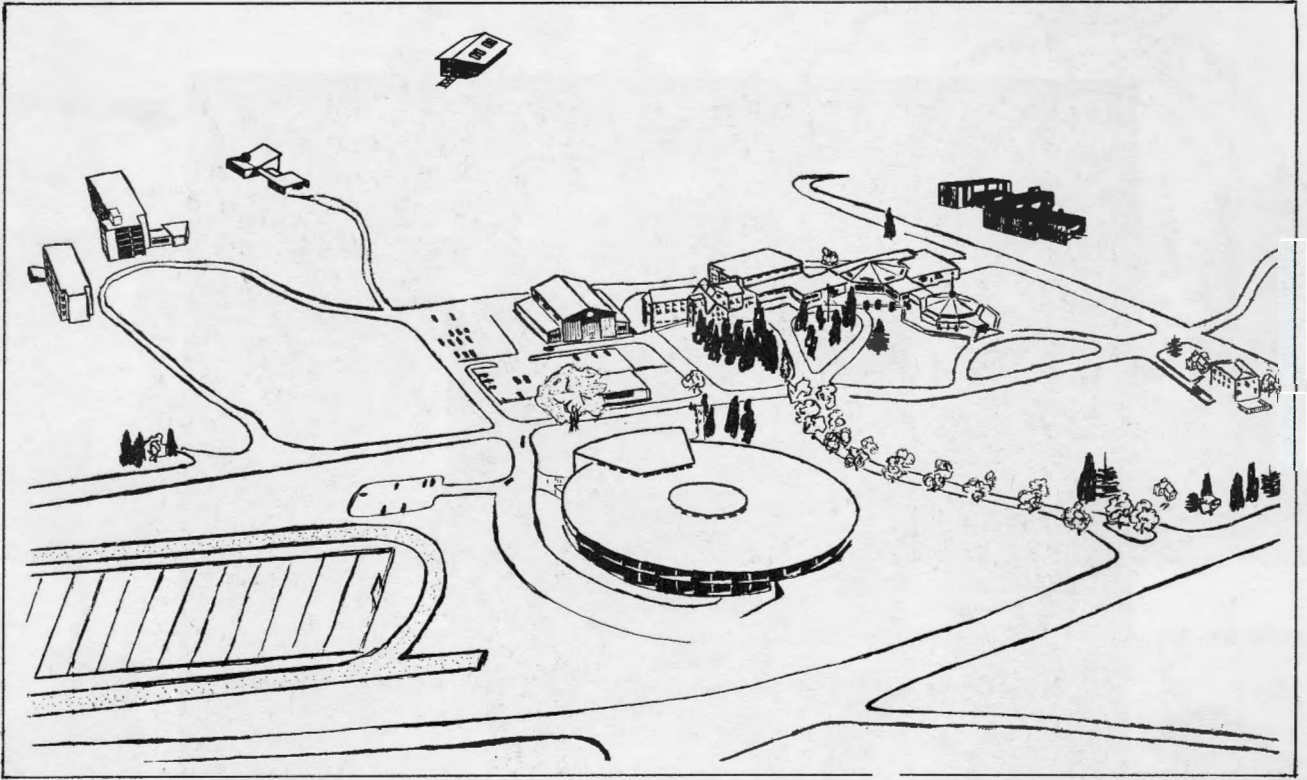
