next to the mosque. Egyptian dignitaries who were
present crying as ones "To heaven, Gamal."


Some thirty minutes later - the streets
surrounding the mosque were aging almost
Deserted - except for those who now slept of when then were by the wayside, 八 hundreds; those whose grief had left them totally drained, unable to even to male their way home.

For President Nixon in Jugoslavia something
of an instant replay today. Jugoslavia's President

Tito pulling a last minute switch; deciding to accompany
the President - on a scheduled solo trip to Zagreb, capital of the Jugoslav republic of Croatia. There
joining the President - in another triumphal motorcade.

It was raining at the start. The President
observing at one point: "I've seen motorcades before but never have $I$ seen so many umbrellas." Then the sun came out the welcoming crowds grow larger and more enthusiastic. Tito observing: "We can get the people to come out - but you know, Mr. President, you cannot force them to smile and show the warmth they have here."

Next on the agenda: A state dinner at the

U S Embassy in Belgrade - the only dinner President

Nixon
 host on his entire trip.

At the peace table in Paris, an exercise today
in facing facts. The communists citing $U$ S refusal
to dump the present "top three" in Saigon - as tacit
proof that the $U S$ has rejected Hanoi's latest peace
initiative; whereupon, America's David Bruce promptly
responded - nothing of the sort.
"Let me merely remark" - Bruce went on
"that it is unreasonable to demand the ouster of the

President, the Vice President and the Prime Minister of the Republican of Viet nam - before you will
negotiate seriously." This would be the same - he
added - "as if we were now to say that the leadership of your side must be removed - before we would be willing to negotiate seriously with you."

Bruce then telling the communists: "The real
question now is - are you prepared to enter into
meaningful negotiations?" For the answer to that though

Meanwhile, the fighting continues - mainly
in Cambodia, where government troops were forced today
to declare an early end - to a planned three
day cease fire in observance of a religious holiday.

This at the instigation of Communist troops - who were taking advantage of the ceasefire to attack a village less than six miles from Phenom rent.

The Compar Cambodians' unilateral stand-down
has also led to a precarious situation in the Provincial
capital of Kompong © Chhnang about sixty miles northwest
of Phenom Pent. Senior officers there reporting:
"Our situation has gone from excellent to awful - almost over night."

More encouraging though - a sum ceremony
today at Been Boa in neighboring South Vietnam where the U S Air Force turned over to the South Vietnamese -
two full squadrons of powerful dragon fly
fighter bombers. General Lucius Clay Jr. -
commander of the Seventh Air Force in Vietnam -
presiding at the official transfer - which he called
an indication of South Vietnam's increased capabilities -
in "assuring its own destiny." Air Force Captain

Ray Wallbridge, a liaison officer, adding that the

South Vietnamese fliers who will now take over the Blanca are "great, really good pilots, with lots of experience."
Moscow - the Kremlin filed a formal protest
with the U Embassy today - charging anti-Soviet
violence by "Zionist extremists" in America. The violence said to include attacks on Soviet trade and diplomatic offices - also, disruptions of performances
by Soviet musical and dance groups. With the chief offender - according to the Kremlin-- the New York
based Jewish Defense League. The Soviets adding that U S authorities must take steps to curb these acts or else risk "unfavorable consequences in relations
between our two states."

At Madrid - a parade of foreign ambassadors today - to the Palace of Spanish strong man Francisco Franco. The diplomats paying their respects to the Generalissimo - on the thirty-fourth anniversary of his ascendance as Spanish Chief of State. Most government office workers were also given the day off - in honor of the occasion.
Otherwise, though - the day passing with little
pomp and less ceremony. They're saving all that $\bar{\lambda}$ we are told - for the arrival of President Nixon, early tomorrow.
