Moscow - the big three western powers

Challenging the Soviet Union - for permitting East

Germany to impose travel restrictions on West Berlin.

This - said to be a violation of the four-power agreements of Nineteen Forty-nine. However, diplomatic sources pe predicting the Russians will simply reject the protests -- one, two, three.
