

Washington tells the Chinese and North Korean communists, all over again - that we stand pat on the composition of the peace conference to settle the Korean war. It must be a two-sided parley - we and they. The sixteen countries that contributed soldiers to the U N forces would sit on one side - the Chinese and North Korean Reds, on the other, with Soviet Russia. If - the Soviets want in.

This is repeated in a diplomatic note, which calls for an early reply - pointing out that the date for the conference is rapidly approaching - October twenty-eighth. And time is needed - for preparations.

At the U N General Assembly, they're waiting for a statement by Moscow Foreign Minister Vishinsky. Yesterday, American Secretary of State John Foster Dulles accused the Reds of stalling on the peace conference. Today, Little went on - the delegations waiting for Vishinsky to reply to that.

UNITED NATIONS - FRANCE

France walked out of the General Assembly of the United Nations today - when Pakistan assailed French policy in North Africa. The French delegation announcing - they will not occupy their places during any discussion of problems in Tunisia and Morocco.

REFUGEE

Word from the U N - that a member of the Red Polish delegation has asked for political asylum. Dr. Marek Korowicz - who served as first alternate at the meeting of the General Assembly, now in session.

The Reds made an oversight - when they assigned this Dr. Korowicz to their delegation going to New York. A University professor, distinguished, competent. But he had one disqualification- no family, no relatives. Nobody whom the Communists might hold - as a hostage.

This fact was not noted - until the Polish delegation was on a trans-Atlantic liner, bound for New York. They couldn't do much about it - out there in the middle of the ocean.

So Korowicz arrived in the United States - delegate to the U N. Then, the next thing you know, he was applying for political asylum, fleeing to freedom.

FOLLOW REFUGEE

Late this afternoon, Dr. Korowicz held a news conference - and told how it happened. He said that, the moment he learned of his appointment as a member of the delegation, he determined to make a break for liberty - when he got to New York

The Polish Reds are housed on the twelfth floor of a Manhattan Hotel. Wednesday morning, at six A.M. the fifty year old University Professor got up, and sneaked down the stairs to the ninth floor. There he took an elevator down, and phoned a Polish refugee, whom he knew. This refugee hid him until today - when Dr. Korowicz made his plea for political asylum.

He told the news conference: "I am very happy to be free ~~in~~ in the free world. Life in Poland is a nightmare."

POLAND

The trial of churchmen in Red Poland brings the usual fantasy of charges. This time, we are told that Cardinal Spellman of New York tried to promote an alliance of the United States and Great Britain with Nazi Germany - for an attack on Soviet Russia.

The yarn begins with something really fantastic - that, when Hitler invaded Poland, the American and British Ambassadors and the Papal Nunzio impeded Polish resistance. They altered the date on the Polish mobilization order - changed the date in a way to delay the massing of Polish troops. ~~But~~ Just how the diplomatic envoys could do that, is a mystery -- how they could alter the date on a mobilization order issued by the Polish government.

Then, in the middle of the war, American Cardinal Spellman tried to bring about a compromise peace with Nazi Germany. For the purpose of an American-British-German attack on Soviet Russia.)

The only evidence of this is testimony at the trial of Bishop Kacmarek and his fellow defendants.

The witness - an obscure individual, who once held a minor diplomatic post.

MCLEAN

There are increasing appearances that Mrs. Donald McLean with her three children, fled to join her husband - behind the Iron Curtain. The American wife of one of the two missing British diplomats, McLean and Burgess - who disappeared. Going over to Communism - it is believed.

Mrs. McLean, living with her American mother at Geneva, Switzerland - said she was driving to a nearby resort to meet a man named "Robin Muir". But, apparently, there was no Robin Muir. The police have now discovered that she drove to Lausanne, where she boarded a train, the conductor says she had tickets for a trip to Austria - passing into Soviet occupied territory.

The British government has asked the Austrian police to search for Mrs. McLean and the three children -- but there wouldn't be much chance of ever finding them, if they took refuge with the Russians.

IRAN

The political situation in Iran is complicated by the attitude of one of the powerful tribes. The Ghashghai threaten - they'll march on Teheran, with seventy thousand warriors.

The new government of Premier Zahedi sent an emissary - to the tribe in the wild mountains of southern Iran. There he was confronted by the tribal chief, Nasser Khan. A giant of a man, standing six foot six. Mr Nasser Khan told him - the tribe was loyal to the Shah, Mohammed Pahlevi, But demanded - the release of the deposed Premier, Mossadegh, Who is charged - with treason. Mossadegh to be turned loose, together with his followers under arrest. If not, the Ghashghai - would march. Seventy thousand of them - well armed with rifles.

Today, the Iranian Chief of Staff said: "Let's see what ~~xxx~~ their rifles can do against our tanks."

KENYA

From East Africa, comes a grim item of law court news. Today, in the troubled Province of Kenya, the high tribunal imposed the sentence of hanging - on forty-four members of the Mau Mau. Convicted of a ferocious massacre, in the spring.

At the village of Lari, the Kenya tribesmen stood in opposition to the secret murder society. The Mau Mau raided the village - for a deed of brutal barbarism. Killing - one-hundred-and-fifty.

(British justice acted sternly - with a round-up of terrorists. Altogether, one-hundred-and-five have been tried and convicted. Forty-four -- sentenced by the Kenya Supreme Court today.

MCCARTHY

There was a rowdy scene at a hearing in Washington today - when Senator McCarthy of Wisconsin had a witness ejected. Abraham Unger, who was an attorney in the defense of the eleven Communist leaders during the conspiracy trial in ~~Nineteen-forty~~ ~~several years ago.~~ Nineteen-~~49~~.

McCarthy said that Unger, yesterday, talked for seventy minutes at a secret session, without ever answering the question - is he a Communist? Today, the lawyer wanted to testify at an open hearing, but McCarthy said he ~~wasn't~~ wasn't going to let the witness make - "a long winded Communist filibuster." He could testify - only if he answered the sixty-four dollar question.

But Unger, nevertheless, went to the witness stand and started talking about his constitutional rights. McCarthy told him to stop. The lawyer went on talking. McCarthy banged his gavel. It did no good. Then the Senator called a guard and said: "Officer, remove that man."

The officer did, and Unger went ~~out~~ out - still talking.

FOUR PERCENTER

Washington reports that the Republican four percenter is getting severe treatment in his party. Warren Stephenson, who was Secretary of the Eisenhower inaugural committee - and who, recently, admitted that he had offered to help a company with a navy contract, in return for a retainer and a four per cent fee.

He has been ousted as Secretary of the District of Columbia Republican club, and removed from the Republican Central Committee in the District.

All - part of the Eisenhower policy of obliterating the peddling of influence.

MOTHER

At Hillside, New Jersey, Mrs. Germaine McGuire says: "I had no time to be frightened. I have two children of my own."
