At Munich, West Germany - a final luncheon today - marking the end of that week-long international banking conference; with the piece de resistance - a real Texas style tongue ~~lash~~ lashing.

U S treasury Secretary John Connolly - who has been fuming privately -- finally giving vent to his emotions. Charging that the six European Common Market countries - also, Japan, and Canada - are chiefly responsible for the present dollar crisis. This - said he - by freezing out American made goods - while refusing to carry a fair share of common defense costs.

Connolly adding - it can't go on; for the simple reason - that the American people are getting angry - and they will refuse ^{to} henceforth - said he - "to engage in any international action in which the true long run interests of the U S - are not just

as clearly recognized as those of the nations with which we deal."

And if there ~~has~~ still remains any doubt - Connolly quickly dispelled it -- stating flatly: "We are not going to devalue the dollar - we are not going to change the price of gold -- we are controlling inflation."

This following the signing of a new thirteen year treaty - pledging an unbreakable friendship between Egypt and Russia. A treaty which is already being hailed - in much of the Arab world, ~~Not so~~ ^{and not} in Israel. ~~though. Indeed,~~ ^S Tel Aviv calling the pact -- "a clear threat to upset the balance of arms in the Middle East."
