*Lest we forget . . .*



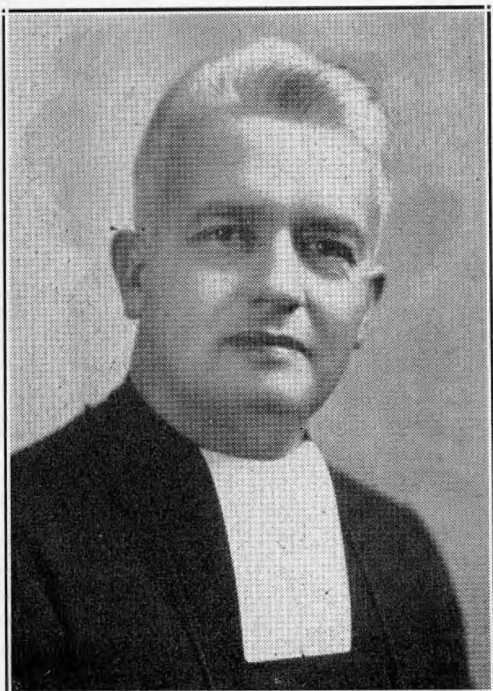
