GOOD EVENING EVERYBODY:

One dangerous aspect about the fighting in
KATANGA - is the amount of animosity it is causing
among the free nations. Specifically, dividing us -
from our closest allies. America, strongly backing
the U action - in Katanga. Britain and Fence, much
less sure - that this $U$ operation ought to be pushed.
Why should the people of Katanga be ruled from
Leopoldville if they don't want to bol Anymore than
the people of Eire, Leland, want to be ruled froe
London, of the vanes from Stockholmand so on.
In Leopoldville today - America was cheered in
the streets. But rioting students attacked the British and French embassies - with stones, and refused to disperse - until premier adoula ace a personal appeal.

In Katanga - the opposite reaction. Premier
Tshombe, bitterly assailing - the United States.
Accusing us of playing - the Communist gaze. Praising
Britain and France - for their understanding of the
Congo problem.
This split among the western allies - almost suse
to get worse. Especially since we have resumed our globe-naster airlift to Elizabethville - withyixusx a
U. 1 . fighter escort. London, not going - nearly that
far. Agreeing to let the $U \|$ have british bombe -
only with the stipulation that they be used yous
against airfields and grounded planes.

## RUSK FOLLOW CONGO

At his news conference today, Secretary of State Rusk emphasized - our attitude to Katanga. Dean Rusk, insisting - that the Congo faces two alternatives: Either an integrated nation - including Katanga; Or an independent Katanga - and civil war. Hence, our all-out support - for the UN. In Rusk's words - "The UN mus not be prevented from fulfilling its mandate. ${ }^{\prime \prime}$ The Secretary of State, adding that this Katanga operation began - only after repeated
attacks on UN personnel by Tshombe's army.

GOA

The Prime minister of India refuses to order
the Indian aral - into Goa. Nehru, telling the "er Delhi parliament - he still wants to settle the dispute peaceably. That he expects that eventually the Portuguese will leave their historic enclave - on the West coast of the sub-continent of Hindustan, that goes back to the golden days of the great Portuguese navigators Alfonso Albaguerque, Vasco de Gama, and

Prince Henry. Still, the Portuguese - aren't taking any
chances. They are mining the border - between Goa and india. Sending out frontier patrols - around the clock. Lisbon, repeating that the Portuguese have no intention of abandoning Goa - Which they have held since the Sixteenth Century. The bones of St. Francis Xavier are in the great cathedral there; where pilgrims kiss St. Francis toe; in Moraugoa, Goa.

The government crack-down on the Cuban news agency
in New York - has nothing to do with freedom of the press.
Attorney General Robert Kennedy explicitly says - that

Prensa Latina can write any way it pleases. Uncle Sam, protecting its right to independent coverage of the news even though Prensa Latina persistently distorts the truth; Turning out - biased anti-American, pro-Castro copy.

Today's indictment by the Federal Grand Jury - a
simple matter of enforcing the law. Prensa Latina - financed and controlled by Castro. Hence, compelled by law to register - as an agent of the Cuban government. Chief correspondent Francisco Portela, accused of - not registering. For which he could get - ten years, and a twenty thousand dollar fine.

All because he pretends to be a legitimate newsman propaganda
when actually he's a mouthpiece for the Red regime in Havana.

The winner of the Nobel Peace Prize - retroactive
to Nineteen Sixty - was the center of a riotous demunstration
when he spoke to newsmen in 0s10. Albert Luthuli of South


Africa, a former Zulu chief - loudly applauged when he denounced the South African policy of apartheid.

At that point, Professor Carl Borgin of the

Stellenbosch University in South Africa - began to heckle Luthuli. Asking whether the Nobel prigeman favors - left wing socialism? Whether he thinks - that the Ghana government was democratically elected? And ${ }^{\circ} 0$ on.

Borgin, continuing $h$ is barrage of provocative questioning- until the audience gegan to jeer him. The news conference, breaking up - in disorder.

That fire in the hospital at Hartford, Connecticut

dollars; to get an American team - to the top of the highest mountain.

When? Next May. Leader - Norman Dyhrenfurth of Santa Monica. Thirty-three thousand - just to get the expedition to Nepal. Forty-one thousand - for equipment, fifteen thousand - for oxygen. And so on. Ironically, this is another case where the wealthiest nation in the world - doesn't contribute a penny. Secretary of Interior Udall, who recently made a Winter climb of Fujiyama in Japan - wants uncle Sam to help.

The self-appointed censor of British royalty - has
turned his attention to the Joneses. Meaning - Princess Margaret and Anthony Armstrong Jones; Othecmisa town over the Earl and Countess of Snowdon.

Lord Altringham, suggesting that the Royal Joneses ought to abdicate. Follow the example of Princess Margaret's uncle - who once was Edward the Eighth, and has been the Duke of Windsor since he decided to marry Mrs. Simpson.
