*At Saigon another attempt today to form a new government. South Vietnam's President Tran Van Huong - meeting with Big Minh; attempting to arrange it so that General Minh can head a delegation to arrange a peace with Hanoi.*

*There are some still willing to fight to the end; among them, former Vice President Nguyen Cao Ky - who told a Catholic rally today: "Our backs are against the wall - we are fighting for our very survival; so, let the cowards go those who are leaving with the Americans and let those who love South Vietnam stay and fight."*

SENATE FOLLOW SAIGON

Here at home the Senate today approved  
a compromise bill ~~providing~~<sup>for</sup> more than three  
hundred million in humanitarian aid to Vietnam; ~~and~~,  
~~at the same time~~<sup>also</sup> urging the President to evacuate  
all Americans forth-with.

But The House <sup>was</sup> not in session today,

until next Tuesday.

WHITE HOUSE

In a special message to congress - President Ford today requested a five year extension - of the present general revenue sharing program. The President noting that revenue sharing, as originally instituted by <sup>Pres.</sup> ~~Richard~~ Nixon - has proved "a resounding success"; over the past three years - returning about nineteen billion in federal taxes to states and local communities.

NEW HAVEN FOLLOW WHITE HOUSE

The President, ~~later travelling to~~ <sup>at</sup> Yale
