New York City - a court case today involving the right of an apartment dweller - to keep a dog.

In this case - a great dane. Judge Edward Greenfield ruling - in the absence of compelling evidence to the contrary -- it's perfectly legal.

In passing though, the Judge also noting that mankind - is apparently divided into three factions.
