The nuclear test ban treaty agreed on by the Moscow negotiators - comes after years of frustration. We've heard over and over - about the intransigence of the Russians. We were warned that Khrushchev didn't want an agreement - just a soundingboard for his propaganda.

But, there was another school of thought which argued like this. That the Russians - are realists. That they become conciliatory - when they find it in their own interest to play it that way. So, be patient, keep negotiating - and wait for the break. For the present that philosophy seems to be vindicated by the events in Moscow. The split with Red China pushed Khrushchev toward the West. And, now the agreement haminered out in just over a week by Gromyko, Hailsham, and Harriman - formulating the terms - of a partial nuclear test ban. No more atomic explosions by any of the signatories - either in the atmosphere, under water, or in outer space.
