AGREEING TO SOVIET PROPOSALS FOR BEGINNING MEGOTIATIONS BY THE ANDASSADORS WHO WILL DISCUSS ARRANGEMENTS, . FOR A CONFERENCE OF THE FOREIGN MINISTERS. THESE, IN TURN TO LAY PLANS FOR A MEETING OF THE CHIEFS OF STATE. TODAYS NOTE FROM THE VESTERN POWERS, HOWEVER, WARKS THE SOVIETS ... THE PRELIMINARIES MUST RESULT IN A PROMISE OF PRACTICAL RESULTS ... OR THERE WON'T BE ANY SUMMIT COMPERENCE. THEY MAKE IT CLEAR THEY DON'T WANT A TOP LEVEL FERTORMANCE TO BE BO MORE THAN A STAGE FOR COMMUNIST PROPAGANDA. SO THE ANDASSADORS WILL BEGIN THE PRELIMINARIES IN MOSCOW, TOMORROW. WHAT ABOUT THE PRENCH GOVERNMENT. OF RATHER, THE PRENCH LACK OF A GOVERNMENT. PREMIER GAILLARDS MINISTRY ... HAVING BEEN OVERTHROWN LAST NIGHT, JUST AS REGOTIATIONS ARE ABOUT TO BEGIN. not affect the preparations for the big doings at the summit. Because the discussions are just beginning - and, presumably, France will have a new Premier and Cabinet by the time the talks reach a critical stage.

In London, today, West German Chancellor Adenauer began a four day visit for talks with British officials. One dominant subject - the summit conference.

Quick results - to begin with. The Chancellor having an hour-and-a-half talk with British Prime Minister MacMullan, in which they promptly reached what they called - "full agreement". Adenauer - anxious to get renewed British pledges, that, when the Chiefs of State meet - the question of German reunification will be included in their discussions. Presumably, the Prime Minister gave him reassurances on that point.

At the White House, today, the reporters asked President Eisenhower about statements made by Dean Acheson, Secretary of State in the Truman administration.

Who expressed his disapproval of a summit conference, arguing, for one thing, that a President might be unduly influenced by pressures at a top level meeting. President Eisenhower replied that he agrees with Achenson on that point, but that he's willing to take the risk, if he finds theres any real promise of achieving results. NATO.

#### EISENHOWER-DEFENSE.

PRESIDENT BISENHOWER SENT CONGRESS, TODAY, HIS PROPOSED LIGISLATION FOR REORGANIZING THE DEFENSE DEPARTMENT. THE PROPOSALS PROVIDING THAT THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE SHALL HAVE GREATER AUTHORITY IN B CONTROLLING THE ARMED FORCES. TODAYS PRESIDENTIAL MESSAGE, HOWEVER, DO NOT INCLUDE ONE CONTROVERSIAL ITEM:T.THAT THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE SHALL HAVE LARGE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF SPENDING MONEY, ALLOCATING FUNDS. IN COMMENS, THERE MEEN CRITICISM.... THAT GREATER FINANCIAL COMPROL WOULD MAKE THE SECRETARY A "CLAR". TODAY THE FRESIDENT EXPLAINED THAT HE'LL GIVE HIS RECOMMENDATION IN THE MATTER OF MONEY, THE WHEN HE SUBMITS A NEW BUDGET TO COMERCES IN JANUARY. SPACE .

DR. VON BRAUN DECLARING - THAT THE ARMY WANTS TO SHOOT A ROCKET INTO OUTER SPACE WITH A HUMAN PASSENGER ABOARD. IN SUCH A WAY -THAT THE PASSENGER WILL RETURN TO EARTH SAFELY. HUGH DRYDEN, DIRECTOR OF THE NATIONAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON AERONAUTICS, WHO STATED THAT THE PROPOSAL DESCRIBED BY - 2 -

DR. VON BRAUN WAS A MERE STUNT. "THE SAME TECHNICAL VALUE," SAID DR. DRYDEN, "AS THE CIRCUS STUNT OF SHOOTING A LADY FROM A CANNON."

WHICH WAS FOLLOWED BY AN OPINION FROM LIEUTENANT GENERAL DONALD PUTT, MISSILE EXPERT FOR THE AIR FORCE. WHO SAID THE ARMY PROJECT WOULD BE WHAT HE CALLED - "JUST A BALLISTIC RIDE."

THE GENERAL SAID THE AIR FORCE WANTS TO TRY SOMETHING ELSE. PUT A PASSENGER IN A SATELLITE WHICH WOULD GO INTO ORBIT. NOT JUST A ROCKET SHOT - TAKING A HUMAN BEING FOR A RIDE. BUT -A MAN-MADE MOON WITH A MAN IN IT. Long round and
