Recently when $I$ was off on a trip to Alaska and to the islands in the mid-Pacific an old friend departed to join fellow explorers in the next world. At the time I didn't even know of it; and even though it happened a month ago 1 still want to pay tribute to one of the finest men I ever knew, Admiral Donald Macmillan, last survivor of the Peary expedition, the one that finally got to the North Pole.

Admiral "Mac" led thirty expeditions to the far North, and died at age ninety-five, one of the most admired men of his time.,
 who also has made many journeys to the Arctic. amazing speaker. An evening with her is an evening of excitement, high adventure - and laughter.

The New York Times in its salute to Macmillan mentioned that he personally finally made it all the way
