Lynette "Squeaky" Fromme of Sacramento was sentenced today, to life in prison - for attempting to assassinate President Ford. Judge MacBride saying he had searched in vain for any mitigating circumstance -that might have permitted a lesser sentence. Also, taking note of a hundred-and-thirty-page document the defendant had sent him - dealing with environmental protection. The Judge telling Miss Fromme: "I am convinced you would murder or cause others to murder - because of your false and distorted belief that violence can save the environment." "Our most precious natural resource" - he added - "is human life."
