SUKARNO

In Jakarta -- President Sukarno of Indonesia today made his first public appearance - since that attempted leftist coup, and,

Sukarno, in effect, rejecting the demands of his loyal generals - as well as student demonstrators, Demands that he outlaw - the Communist party, Instead, calling for national harmony, And warning against any unfounded accusations - that might create disunity.

# VIETNAM

U.S. Air Force and Navy jets returned to the attack today -- over Communist North Vietnam; blasting a widespread series of targets -- that included a North Vietnamese military supply camp said to have been eighty-five per cent destroyed in the attack.

While to the south -- the big big B.-Fifty-Twos blasted an area about seventy-five miles northwest of Saigon, suspected headquarters -- of the Viet Cong political high command.



CASE

A difficult decision today in Shrewsbury, England -- in a difficult case. That of Arthur Gray -- who killed his only son. As the boy lay dying -- of incurable cancer of the spine.

Gray pleading guilty -- to a charge of manslaughter. However, the <sup>was</sup> court told by a prosecutor - that twelve year old Donald was already partially paralyzed. That he was " in the greatest misery and agony" - an agony "shared by his parents." And that his death was quick - and painless.

After hearing the evidence - Justice Streatfield of Shrewsbury - ordered the father placed on probation for two years. ~~The offense - dreadful enough~~ - Said the Judge:-

~~Adding that~~ "I am the last person in the world- to think of punishing you."

CAVE

*Fifteen year old Morris Baetzold - plucked from the jaws of death today. In a crevice in a cave - near Medina, Ohio. A crevice where he had been wedged head-first, head-down - for twenty six hours.*

*Hero of the day - also fifteen. A slender eagle scout - named Michael Ulrich. Who slipped into a narrow space near the entombed youth - and fastened a nylon harness to his waist -- the harness - enough to dislodge the trapped youngster. With huskier rescue workers - then able to complete the job.*

SMOKING

At San Francisco - the Sixty=Third Annual  
Convention of the American Automobile Association, ~~And~~  
from that meeting <sup>came</sup> a report today showing a definite  
correlation between smoking - and traffic accidents,  
~~As~~ presented by Dr. James Malfetti - of Columbia  
University.

The report - based on a study of professional  
drivers. Truck drivers, cab drivers, bus drivers -- and  
and the like. Showing that nearly half of the drivers in  
the high accident group - were inveterate smokers, while  
of those in the no-accident group - only one-sixth of them  
were smokers.

The "why" of the accidents - we don't yet know -  
said Dr. Malfetti. But the evidence - unmistakable.  
The smoking driver most likely of all - to make an ash  
of himself.
