MIAMI BEACH

DEMONSTRATORS

Elsewhere in Miami Beach hundreds of anti-war protesters were off on a bit of a tear today; that is tearing down political posters - burning American flags - breaking windows - and beating a few people over the head. This leading to the first mass arrest since the start of the convention. As they were hauled away in paddy wagons - the protestors singing a song entitled: All we're saying - is give peace a chance."

Meanwhile, at Paris - the Viet Cong were ~~even~~ attacking ~~today~~ the Republican party platform; charging that said document - "glorifies the policy of Vietnamization of the war." Adding if the President really wants peace all he has to do is "one - stop the bombing of Vietnam; two - withdraw all U S troops; and three - dump South Vietnam's President Thieu;" in which case - we are told "peace can be achieved within several days."

MUNICH FOLLOW KAMPALA

At Munich today, at a meeting of the International Olympic Committee, its members voted thirty-six to thirty-one - to oust white supremacist Rhodesia from the summer Olympic games. This in the face of a threatened walkout - by a least fifteen black African nations; although seven Rhodesia's team members are also black.

MOSCOW

Moscow - a Kremlin crack-down on the Soviet motion picture industry; startling ~~out today~~ with the firing of Soviet film Czar Alexai Romanov; on the grounds that many of his films - "lack ideological purposefulness;" ~~that they~~ fail to give quote - "a truthful showing of life from the position of Lenin."

The Kremlin ^{is} also accusing Russian film makers - of attempting to copy "the methods of foreign cinematography." Observing; ^{quote:-} "On the screen - we rarely see heroes who would attract us by their human ~~charm~~ charm - by their devotion to Communist ideals; while, at the same time, exaggerated attention is paid to personages - who lack deep social interests and firm moral standards."

The Kremlin serving notice, in short, no more "boy meets girl" - no more "love stuff." From now on - strictly "comraderie."
