*At Estes Park, Colorado - another session of that White House Youth Conference; whose leaders announced today the results of a conference vote - on a resolution urging the resignation of President Nixon and Vice President Agnew.*

*And how did it come out? Well, maybe a bit of a surprise. The young people present - including a number of self-avowed militants -- voting one-~~or~~-three to fifty-nine - to kill the resolution. For the Nixon Administration -- a winning margin of nearly two to one. With adult delegates - who also considered the same resolution - giving the Administration an even greater margin - nearly four to one.*

## SENATE FOLLOW A SHAW

Here at home - a meeting of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee -- attended by more than a hundred anti-war protestors. These cheering the remarks of Senator McGovern of South Dakota and Senator Hatfield of Oregon -- both of whom strongly criticize U S Vietnam ~~is~~ policy. And then they booed and ~~hissed~~ hissed when Senator Case of New Jersey rose to the challenge. The latter finally pounding his fist on the table - ~~demanding~~ demanding that Chairman Fulbright "keep order ~~there~~ thereby rejecting the ~~return~~ return to the so-called "neighborhood school" system.

WASHINGTON

In the wake of that Republican Governors' conference -- another flap of sorts today in Washington; with Vice President Spiro Agnew quoted as criticizing U S press handling of Red China's so-called "Ping-Pong" diplomacy; supposedly adding that this amounted to a propaganda beating - that could undermine U S support of nationalist China. All of which ~~was seen - by some - as an~~ <sup>made some wonder, is there an</sup> apparent conflict in Administration policy?

UNITED NATIONS FOLLOW WASHINGTON

Meanwhile, the Captain of the U S Table Tennis Team, ~~was~~ just back from Red China -- <sup>called at</sup> ~~visiting today~~ the United Nations. Jack Howard of Seattle there observing that the Chinese he saw - were "not oppressed, or compressed, or depressed." But rather, "quite content."

He also said ~~though~~ - that "everything is planned from above;" to the point he continued - where he once asked his interpreter - if he had no desire to "do your own thing"; whereupon the interpreter asked quite seriously "how do you do it?"

Incidentally, Soviet Communist Party leader Leonid Brezhnev - one of the foreign ~~also~~ dignitaries in attendance receiving <sup>ed</sup> a roaring welcome <sup>from the</sup> ~~from a big crowd of~~ Bulgarians - ~~a roaring welcome. Diplomatic sources noting however,~~
