## HOUSE

*Treasury Secretary Simon today told the Senate panel reviewing Secret Service procedures, that in the first twenty days of September - there were, by actual count, three hundred and twenty threats against the President's life. This he blamed in part - on all the publicity given Lynnette Fromme. "When these people are glamorized on the front pages of our national magazines" - said Secretary Simon, "this has to be thought of as doing great harm."*
