GOOD EVENING EVERYBODY :

California's high Sierra forest fires have destroyed enough timber to build at least six-thousand houses. Hardest hit, the Sierra National Forest - where the blaze is raging along a twenty-five-mile front. Campers, warned to leave the nearby areas - before the fire catches up with them. Meanwhile, twelve hundred men are struggling - to keep the flames from spreading. Five-hundred Indians from Arizona and New Mexico - were flown in today. Experts in the traditional lore of the forest - that goes back to pre-Columbian days Modern equipment is being used - especially tanker planes loaded with anti-fire chemicals. The trouble is that there's so much territory - to cover - in the High Sierra.
