sentenced to twenty-seven months in prison. Which he never served - having got away to Argentina. The prison sentence wares later dismissed, under an amnesty. But now, Vittorio Mussolini, forty years old, has returned from Argentina to Italy; to clear himself - of the charge of desertion.

Before a military court in Florence, he raw presented evidence - that he was in Germany during his leave of absence. The Nazis - not permitting him to return.
