President Nixon's visit to Madrid today - ~~proved~~ <sup>proved to be</sup>

the emotional highlight of his current European Tour.

With a crowd of ~~over~~ <sup>5</sup> more than a million Spaniards trading siesta for fiesta; giving the President the biggest, most rousing reception - of his entire political career.

To begin with - an airport welcome; where the President called Spanish American friendship - "an indispensable pillar for peace," in the Mediterranean. Then the President and Spain's Generalissimo Franco boarding an open limousine, standing side by side as they passed through a canyon of humanity - shouting over and over "Nixon! Nixon! Nixon! bravo! bravo! bravo! Franco! Franco! Franco!"

Later, in the Plaza del Marques del Duero - Madrid's mayor presenting Mr. Nixon <sup>with</sup> a golden key to the city. Again - a thunder of bravos. This time, the President plunging into the crowd to ~~do~~ shake hands with the crowd and there he was warmly embraced. <sup>The</sup> President

calling it - "a very ~~amazing~~ exciting reception;" and  
the crowd said he "the largest I've ever seen."

## **DUBLIN FOLLOW MADRID**

*After Spain the President is heading next for Britain - then Ireland. The first - always a welcome stop; but the second - well, that's something else again.*

*Dublin authorities imposing today - the tightest security in Irish history. Banning all public demonstrations - also banning all public cars from downtown Dublin and Limerick. This in an attempt to head off protest movements - led by a coalition of anti-Vietnam war groups. Even Irish Quaker leaders joining today in protesting the President's visit.*

CAIRO

*The passing of Egypt's President Nasser - the frenzy of his funeral - now a ~~matter~~ matter of history.*

*Thus in Cairo today - a return to the business of ~~the~~ the living. Visiting Soviet Premier Kosygin conferring with Egypt's acting President - Anwar El-Sadat - also, ~~the~~ former Premier Aly Sabry. These seen as the top contenders - to ~~successor~~ succeed Nasser. Kosygin having already pledged Russia's full support - both economically and militarily - whoever wins out.*

**ADD CAIRO**

*Later on, official U S representatives at Nasser's funeral - also conferring with the two top Egyptian leaders. Telling them the U S considers alleged Egyptian cease fire violations - as the "principal obstacle" to resuming Mid-East peace talks. However, the Egyptians, it seems - chiefly concerned with complaining about the proposed sale of U S warplanes to Israel.*

## **BAKU FOLLOW CAIRO**

*In the meantime, Soviet Communist party leader Brezhnev - travelling to the city of Baku on the Caspian Sea. There <sup>to</sup> ~~helping to~~ celebrate - the fiftieth anniversary of the Soviet Republic of Azerbaijan. He also charged in a major speech that - "Israeli ruling circles - with the support of the U S government - are doing everything possible to wreck" the current U N peace effort in the Middle East.*

Golda ~~Meier~~ Meier addressing her own nation today - on the occasion of the Jewish New Year. Asserting once more that Israel is ready to resume peace talks under

U N auspices - just as soon as Egyptian cease-fire

violations have been rectified. <sup>She</sup> ~~she~~ also disclosed that

Israel had been ready to intervene in Jordan - if King

Hussein had lost out in his struggle with Arab Guerrillas.

Madame Meier adding that, in ~~the event~~ any event - Israel

becomes stronger militarily and economically each year;

which brings it closer each year - said she - to peace with

the Arabs.

## WASHINGTON

The U S unemployment rate - up sharply last month. According to government figures announced today - jumping from five point one percent to a full five and a half percent. This marking the highest level - in nearly seven years. However, officials noting that most of the jobless increase - occurred among men aged sixteen to twenty-four. Adding that this year's survey was undertaken prior to Labor Day - which fell on the ~~9th~~ eighth rather than after labor Day, as is ~~was~~ usually the case. Hence, many of these men - have ~~most~~ probably since returned to school.
