President Eisenhower, today, stated that one possible solution of the China coast crisis might be - to "demilitarize" those off-shore islands. It was the strongest official declaration thus far to kmk that effect.

The President - giving his own professional opinion as a military man, General Ike Saying - that Quemoy and Matsu are not exf of much importance. He put it in these words:

"Fundamentally, anyone can see that the two islands, as two pieces of territory - are not vital to Formosa."

He said he thought - the Chinese Nationalists should not have put eighty-five thousand troops on Quemoy, in the first place.

However, the President admitted that a formula of "demilitarizing" the islands might not satisfy all concerned.

He didn't say - just who might fail to be satisfied. But, Chiang Kai-Shek has declared himself - agam against any proposal to remove nationalist forces from Quemoy and Matsu. His opposition

- reiterated again today, by a spokesman for the Nationalists.

Well, if I were to make a guess - it would be what you too, most likely are guessing at this moment. That, in the negotiations between the United States and the Chinese Reds-a compromise may be under discussion. Providing for - "demilitarization."

At the Quemoy Islands, today, a thundering barrage one-hundred-and-fifty-one shells a minute. In spite of which,
however - the Nationalists were able to get in **tiwht** with
another supply convoy.

The heaviest blast - hurled at Little Quemoy, Island.

Where the word is - that the garrison and civilian population have only about three weeks food supplies left.

Soviet Russia proposes - a conference of the Foreign Ministers of the Big Three. For the purpose - of ending atomic testing. A ban - "for eternity", says the Soviet note. Delivered in Moscow, today - to the British and American Ambassadors.

All of which comes - as the Soviets have resumed nuclear testing. With two explosions of moderate size - in the Arctic. So reported - by the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission.

Simultaneous announcement in London and Amman,
the capital of Jordan, today: The British - to begin the
withdrawal of their troops from Jordan, on October Twentieth.
So stated - by King Hussein in addressing the Jordanian
parliament. The Foreign office in London - confirming it.

Americans are withdrawing - the British following suit.

Today, however, General Ne Win, the Premier

Designate, said- the political power was turned over to him

personally, as an individual. Not, in any way, to the armed

forces. He promises free elections in Burma, six months after

he assumes office.

I, myself, was out in Burma a few months ago. And, from what I could see, the likelihood of orderly democratic raiding going on government looked remote. Fighting and travel disturbances all over Burma.
