

The unity statement that Barry Goldwater made in Hershey, Pennsylvania - emphasizes the "Dulles-Eisenhower approach." Goldwater insisting, that as President he would conduct foreign policy along the lines of President Eisenhower - and John Foster Dulles. In fact, this year's G.O.P. standard bearer promises to check with General Ike - about critical Cabinet choices, the Secretary of State, for instance - and the Secretary of Defense.

At home, Goldwater repudiates extremists - like the Ky Klux Klan; vows to enforce - the Civil Rights Law, and flatly denies that he "shoots from the hip" - either literally or metaphorically.

The Goldwater statement is intended to mollify - the Republican moderates, and to bring back those who have been threatening to disavow - the Goldwater-Möller ticket. As the Arizonan puts it - "We seek to read no one out of this Party."

UNITY FOLLOW GOLDWATER

How much unity - did the "unity speech" achieve? Former Pres. Eisenhower says of Goldwater and Miller - "I shall support them to the best of my ability." Ex-Vice-President Nixon also promises - to campaign for the ticket. As does the man who fought Goldwater at the Convention - the host of the Republican summit conference - Governor Scranton of Pennsylvania.

Nelson Rockefeller, on the other hand - may not leave his state during the campaign and will confine himself to supporting - Republicans of New York. Governor Romney of Michigan is still to be heard from. In other words - it was a unity session at which no leading Republican repudiated the man from Arizona.

PAKISTAN

Two nations that have not always been the best of friends - India and Pakistan - are being brought together by the forces of nature. New Delhi and Karachi, considering - a plan for joint flood control.

JOHNSON
