

**GOOD EVENING EVERYBODY:**

The only question about a Congressional resolution on Castro's Cuba is whether the wording will be accepted unanimously. Everybody on Capitol Hill wants a tough statement - of our attitude toward Soviet penetration of this Hemisphere. And everybody hopes that the way it's drafted - that the language will pass - without a dissenting vote, as happened with the Resolution approved today - by the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, and The Senate Armed Services Committee. All thirty-three senators, answering, "Aye" - when they were polled.

The key sentence in today's resolution - reads like this. "The United States will prevent the spread of Communism from Cuba - by whatever means may be necessary, including arms."

## LEGISLATION

PRESIDENT KENNEDY WINS HIS GREATEST LEGISLATIVE VICTORY - OF HIS ADMINISTRATION. THE SENATE, PASSING THE PRESIDENT'S TRADE BILL - VIRTUALLY IN THE FORM HE ASKED FOR. THE VOTE, OVERWHELMING - SEVENTY-EIGHT TO EIGHT.

THE BILL EXTENDS THE RECIPROCAL TRADE AGREEMENT - FOR ANOTHER FIVE YEARS. MORE IMPORTANT, IT ALLOWS THE PRESIDENT TO CUT TARIFFS AT HOME - AS FOREIGN TARIFFS GO DOWN. NO PRESIDENT HAS EVER HAD THIS POWER BEFORE - BUT MR. KENNEDY POINTED OUT THAT HE MUST BE ABLE TO ACT QUICKLY, TO KEEP US ABREAST OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENTS ABROAD. CONGRESS, AGREEING - TO THAT. THE ONLY PROBLEM OF THE TRADE BILL NOW - IRONING OUT MINOR DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE HOUSE AND SENATE VERSIONS.

AID

MEANWHILE, THE FOREIGN AID BILL - IS HAVING A MORE DIFFICULT TIME IN CONGRESS. THAT'S WHY SECRETARY OF STATE RUSK - WAS BACK ON CAPITOL HILL TODAY. DEAN RUSK, APPEALING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE FIGURE  $\neq$  SUGGESTED BY THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE. THE COMMITTEE, SLASHING OVER A BILLION DOLLARS - FROM THE PRESIDENT'S REQUEST. SECRETARY RUSK, TERMING THIS "EXTREMELY DANGEROUS" - WHEN OUR ALLIES NEED OUR HELP, TO SAVE THEIR INDEPENDENCE.

TAYLOR

THE MAN DUE TO BECOME OUR NEXT CHAIRMAN OF THE  
JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF - IS OPTIMISTIC ABOUT THE SITUATION  
IN SOUTH VIETNAM. AND THAT'S IMPORTANT, BECAUSE BESIDES  
BEING AN OPTIMIST - GENERAL MAXWELL TAYLOR IS A REALIST.  
HE WAS BROUGHT INTO THE KENNEDY ADMINISTRATION AFTER THE  
CUBAN FIASCO - AND TOLD TO EVALUATE OUR MILITARY  
COMMITMENTS, AROUND THE WORLD. EVALUATE THEM - REALISTICALLY.

HIS REALISTIC OPINION, AFTER A TOUR OF SOUTH  
VIETNAM, <sup>is that</sup> - "WE ARE ON THE ROAD TO VICTORY," <sup>So says</sup> GENERAL  
MAXWELL TAYLOR.

COMMONWEALTH

THE COMMONWEALTH COMMUNIQUE - YES, THE LONDON CONFERENCE FINALLY MANAGED TO COME UP WITH ONE - CONCEDES THE MAIN POINT. THE PRIME MINISTERS FROM THE FORMER BRITISH EMPIRE - APPROVING BRITISH ENTRY INTO THE COMMON MARKET. BUT WITH MANY QUALIFICATIONS - TO MAKE IT EASIER FOR THEM TO LIVE WITH THE NEW ARRANGEMENT. THAT QUESTION OF COMMONWEALTH PRODUCTS DETOURED FROM BRITAIN - SELLING ON THE CONTINENT.

THE MOST RELIEVED MAN IN LONDON TONIGHT - PRIME MINISTER MAC MILLAN. THE BRITISH PRIME MINISTER SAID DURING THE TALKS THAT HE SAW NO ALTERNATIVE - TO PUTTING HIS COUNTRY INTO THE EUROPEAN UNION. SO HE'S GRATEFUL TO HIS COMMONWEALTH COLLEAGUES - FOR FINALLY GIVING HIM THE GREEN LIGHT.

## BONDS

THE BILL THAT INVOLVES YOU AND BONDS - IS FARTHER ALONG THE WAY TO THE LAW BOOKS. THE SENATE, FOLLOWING THE LEAD OF THE HOUSE - ENDORSING AMERICAN PURCHASE OF ONE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS WORTH OF U.N. BONDS. THAT IS, IF THE OTHER MEMBER NATIONS PICK UP AN EQUAL AMOUNT. THE PURPOSE OF THE BONDS, OF COURSE, TO KEEP THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FROM GOING BANKRUPT.

THE VOTE IN THE SENATE TODAY - ANOTHER ~~REG-~~ VICTORY FOR PRESIDENT KENNEDY.
