Rawalpindi - President Ayub announcing tonight - he

will lift the state of emergency as of Monday.

On the battlefields of Vietnam - where

at least, the Viet Cong apparently observing their

own self-proclaimed TET truce, with Allied troops

expected to join shortly in a similar pledge of non=

belligerence - for a three day period beginning

Year's observance enemy leaders telling their

troops "to strike harder on every battle field,"

political and military," Radio Hanoi further pledging

New Year's wish". Namely, "to fight so the Americans

go away - to fight so that the puppets fall."
