WEST GERMANY.

West Germany will no longer make payments-  
to support Western Military <sup>forces</sup> ~~forces~~ on German soil.

So stated- by a spokesman of the Bonn Government.

Payments to be discontinued - after may fifth.

This is according to the peace treaty. Which,  
however provides-that the question shall be negotiated.

Last week, the British, French and American governments  
handed the Bonn government a note - suggesting  
negotiations.

Today's declaration is ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ an answer to  
that.

A spokesman pointing out - that no other country,  
under the North Atlantic treaty alliance, makes  
cash payment for the support of nato troops that are  
stationed in its territory. <sup>So</sup> On that basis, west Germany  
replies-no.

GERMANY

The German police reveal the evidence - in the kidnapping of a former inspector-General of the Red Police in East Germany. Colonel Robert Bialek who defect<sup>ed</sup> ~~three years ago~~ three years ago. Granted political asylum in West Berlin-where he published secrets of the Communists.

The report shows that he attended a drinking party at a friend's house in the British sector of Berlin. Three others were present . One-a woman, These, apparently, were secret agents of the Red Police.

Bialek was drugged. <sup>So</sup> The landlord of the building declares. He saw the victim carried away, unconscious. His three drinking companions-putting him in a truck. Which - drove off. Presumably- to the Red sector.

Such are the facts behind the news-in the kidnapping of the former inspector-general of the <sup>East German</sup> Communist police.

FOLLOW GERMANY KIDNAP

Another dispatch indicates a mix-up in family affairs of the West Germany communist leader, Max Reimann. Who has two sons-and both were communist officials in ~~East~~ East Germany.

One of them - deserting the Reds a few years ago. The other - now doing the same thing. ~~THE~~ Hugo Reimann connected with the Red police and the Communist Youth organization.

They say he fell from grace-because he married the daughter of a capitalist. *Fearing* ~~he was afraid of~~ arrest, ~~and~~ <sup>he</sup> now has fled, we hear, to the home of a sister in Munich.

Balloons could be equipped with automatic  
cameras - but how could you get the pictures snapped  
in Russian skies? The balloon <sup>o</sup> would have to go ~~out~~ <sup>on around the globe,</sup>  
<sup>all</sup> the way across to the Pacific, before we could get  
the photographs.

At the state department, spokesman Lincoln  
White says Moscow may be referring to balloons, <sup>certain</sup> <sup>that have been</sup> launched  
for scientific research. <sup>That is,</sup> <sup>has been</sup> The air force ~~making~~ balloons  
observations, in connection with the international  
geophysical year. But no photographic balloons  
sent over Russia!

SUB LEAD NATURAL GAS

Tonight, the Senate passed the natural gas bill, after one of the bitterest fights in the history of Congress. All day long, the debate was hot and heavy ~~and~~ -- with one amendment after another beaten down. Then, tonight, the issue went to a vote. The majority -- fifty three to ~~eighty~~ thirty eight. Passing one of the most controversial bills in ~~the~~ years. Removing government regulation from the producers of natural gas.

NATURAL GAS.

The senate will go ahead with that much debated natural gas bill - in spite of a committee investigation ~~looking~~ into the charge made by senator Francis Case, the South Dakota Republican.

Who stated - that a ~~South Dakota~~ lawyer had contributed twenty-five hundred dollars to the Senator's campaign funds on the assumption-that Case would vote for the bill to make natural gas producers immune from federal price regulation.

This contributor now reveals himself as John M. Neff, of Lexington, Nebraska. Who says-he did make the twenty-five hundred dollar contribution. And he is "interested" in the passage of the natural gas bill. But he declares the money was offered with "no strings attached".

That's being investigated- and , today, senator Potter of Michigan made a motion - To send the measure back to the senate commerce committee, until ~~that~~ inquiry has been made. Motion defeated - si xty-

DRAFT DODGERS .

The house of representatives , today , passed a bill by unanimous vote . A bill to stop - draft dodging of- a most peculiar sort. <sup>Draft</sup> ~~The~~ dodgers-getting into the national military academies, as a way of evading the draft.

Under the law, if a youth is drafted , and he enters West Point, Annapolis or the air force academy - he's not subject to the draft any more. So, all he has to do is go through school-at <sup>(government)</sup> ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ expense. then, upon graduation resign from the army, ~~the~~ navy or ~~the~~ air force. Same thing-if he flunks out , failing to make the grade. Draft dodging - deluxe, <sup>they call</sup> it.

So the defense department asked congress- to put a stop to this. The house-passing the bill, and sending it on to the Senate.

Governor ~~Marvin~~ Griffen of Georgia signed a series of bills, today - to change the Georgia school system from public to private. As a way-to evade the supreme court decision, forbidding racial segregation in schools.

Last year , the Georgia voters ratified a state constitutional amendment. Recently, the state legislatur<sup>e</sup> passed measures-to implement the amend<sup>e</sup>ment. These today, signed by the Governor.

A LABAMA STUDENT.

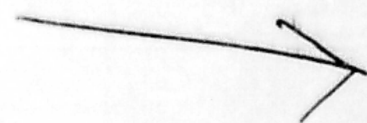

The Solar system-is minus a planet. According to the verdict of Astronomer Dr. Gerard Kuiper, of Yerkes Observatory. The outermost planet - removed from the list.

Pluto - discovered a few years ago.. Not that pluto has run away-escaping from the solar system. But that <sup>heavenly</sup> ~~rocky~~ body is really not-a planet. so says the astronomer of the Yerkes observatory.

Dr. Kuiper explains-that Pluto has not the characteristics of a true planet. Too small - and <sup>with</sup> ~~it~~ has a different kind of orbit. Likewise it rotates too slowly. All of which has been disclosed-by recent careful observation.

So <sup>then</sup> what is Pluto ? ~~a~~ moon, really! ~~a~~ runaway satellite-a former moon on the Planet ~~NEPTUNE~~ Neptune.

The astronomer puts it in these words "Pluto did not start out as a planet. It started out as one of those moons of Neptune. All three broke away, but Neptune recaptured two of them. Pluto,

however," adds the professor, "remains in a separate orbit."

Its as if our own moon <sup>broke</sup> ~~got~~ away <sup>from us,</sup> and went off on a new orbit <sup>rotating</sup> around the sun. That would'nt make it a true planet. ~~just~~ <sup>It would just be</sup> a runaway moon.

Well, ~~it all means that~~ <sup>So</sup> our solar system has eight planets, ~~instead of nine~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~When Pluto was~~ <sup>we thought we had</sup> discovered, ~~it reckoned is~~ <sup>and was said to be</sup> the ninth, ~~but~~ I guess we'll have to get along with eight.
