VIET NAM

SECRETARY OF STATE DEAN RUSK TODAY WARNED NORTH VIET NAM THE CHANCE FOR PEACE TALKS MAY BE LOST IF IT CONTINUES TO INDULGE IN PROPOGANDA OR MISCALCULATE THE AMERICAN RESOLVE. IN A SPEECH BEFORE THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF NEWSPAPER EDITORS IN WASHINGTON, RUSK SAID THAT "SO FAR WE HAVE NOT RECEIVED AN OFFICIAL REPLY TO OUR OFFER TO FIND A MUTUALLY AGREEABLE SITE FOR A CONFERENCE." FILL, DIPLOMATIC SOURCES IN LONDON SAY HANNOI APPEARS ANXIOUS TO HOLD THE TALK DESPITE THE PROLONGED

THESE SOURCES SAY THE DEADLOCK MAY BE BROKEN WITH THE SELECTION OF PARIS AS A COMPROMISE AND UN SECRETARY GENERAL UTHANT AS ANTITHIRD PARTY TO MAKE THE ARRANGEMENTS. IN THE WAR IN ITSELF, FIGHTING CONTINUED WITH ALLIED HEADQUARTERS REPORTING HEAVY AMERICAN LOSSES IN A NEW BATTLE AROUND CA KHESANH. NINETEEN MARIANS WERE KILLED - FIFTY SIX WOUNDED - AND FOURTEEN AND MISSING. THE MARIANES COUNTED TWENTY NORTH VIETNAMESE KILLED.

IN HONOLULU, PRESIDENT JOHNSON MET WITH SOUTH I KOREAN PRESIDENT PARK GHUNG-HEB TO REASSURE HIM THAT THE SEARCE FOR PEACE IN VIET NAM DOES NOT MEAN WE WILL ABANDON THE STRUGGLE AGAINST COMMUNISM IN ASIA. END STORY

ATTACHES

THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT NEWSPAPER, IZ VESTIA, SAYS FIVE AMERICANS AND ONE CANADIAN - ALL MILITARY ATTACHES - WERE CAUGHT SPYING ON A RUSSIAN ARMY CAMP AND A SHIPYARD EARLIER THIS MONTH. SINCE ALL SIX MEN HAVE DIPLOMATIC IMMUNITY THEY WERE NOT UNDER ARREST. THOUGH. THE AMERICANS AND CANADIAN EMBASS IN MOSCOW HAVE PROTESTED THE CHARGES, CALLING THEM UNFOUNDED.

STILL ANOTHER MOSCOW NEWSPAPER STORY CLAIMES THAT AN AMERICAN CIVILIAN - IDENTIFIED AS STEPHEN SUDAKOV - WAS EXPELLED FROM THE SOVIET UNION LAST SUMMER ON A SPYING CHARGE. SUDAKOV WAS TOUR LEADER FOR A GROUP OF STUDENTS FROM INDIANA UNIVERSITY.

RIOTERS

US ATTORNEY GENERAL RAMSEY CLARKE WARNED THAT GIVING POLICE ORDERS TO SHOOT RIOTERS COULD LEAD TO WHAT HE CALLED, "A VERY DANGEROUS ESCALATION" OF RACIAL VIOLENCE IN AMERICAN CITIES. CLARKE SAYS THAT HE DOESN'T BELIEVE THAT SUCH ORDERS ARE PERMISSABLE EXCEPT IN SELF DEFENSE, OR WHEN NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE LIVES OF OTHERS. THE HE OBVIOUSLY REFERRS TO RECENT STATEMENT BY CHICAGO MAYOR RICHARD DALEY WHO SAID HE HAS ORDERED POLICE TO "SHOOT TO KILL", ANY ONE CAUGHT SETTING FIRE TO HOMES AND BUILDINGS, THEREBY ENDANGERING THE LIVES OF OTHERS. DALEY HAS ALSO INSTRUCTED CHICAGO POLICE TO "SHOOT TO MAIN OR CRIPPLE", ANYONE CAUGHT 'LOOTING, IN CHIAGO TODAY, HE REFUSED TO BACK DOWN FROM HIS POSITION, CHARGING THAT "MEN WHO THROW FIRE BOMBS ARE NO DIFFERENT FROM THE ASSINS WHO SHOT PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND MARTIN LUTHER KING."

MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DEMONSTRATORS - MEMBERS OF THE LEFTIST-STUDENTS-FOR-DEMOCRATIC-ACTION - CLASHED WITH POLICE IN NEW YORK TODAY, DURING A PROTEST AGAINST THE RECENT SHOOTING OF GERMAN STUDENT LEADER RUDI DUTSCHKE IN BERLIN. AP-LANST TWELVE OF THE STUDENTS WERE ARRESTED DURING THE DEMONSTRATION AT ROCKEFELLER CENTER OUTSIDE THE OFFICE OF NEWSMEN EMPLOYED BY ALLY SPRINGER - A WEST GERMAN NEWSPAPER -PUBLISHER. LEFT WING STUDENTS STAGED SIMILAR PROTEST IN WEST GERMANY EARLIER THIS WEEK, BLAMING THE ANTI COMMUNIST SPRINGER NEWSPAPERS FOR THE ATTEMPT AGAINST RUDI DUTSCHKE LIFE.

MIDEAST

PROSPECTS FOR A PEACE SETTLEMENT IN THE MID EAST APPEARED TO HAVE PLUNGED TO A NEW LOW AMID REPORTS OF ANNOTHER GUN BATTLE BETWEEN JORDIANIAN AND ISRAED TROOPE ACROSS THE JORDAN RIVER. AN EGYPTIAN GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN SAYS NO PROGRESS WHAT~SO~EVER HAS BEEN MADE TOWARD A LASTING PEACE SETTLEMENT BETWEEN ISRAEL AND THE ARAB STATES.

PRISON

FIVE PRISONERS WERE KILLED AND SEVENTY EIGHT INJURED TODAY BY GUARDS IN AN UPRISING AT NORTH CAROLINAS CENTRAL PRISON IN RALEIGH. THE REBELLION ERUPTED AFTER A SIT DOWN STRIKE, WITH THE PRISONERS DEMANDING HOT LUNCHES, LONGER VISITING HOURS, AND MORE TELEVISION PRIVILEGES.

IN WASHINGTON, THE US TAX COURT RULLED THAT GOING TO THE SOUTH POLE WON'T STOP THE GOVERNMENT FROM COLLECTING YOUR INCOME TAXES. THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE CLAIMED THAT LARRY MARTIN OF WELLESLEY, MASSACHUSETTS, OWED MORE THAN A THOUSAND DOLLARS IN FEDERAL TAXES ON MONEY HE EARNED SIX YEARS AGO WHILE EMPLOYED WITH AN EXPEDITION TO ANTARTICA.
