LAS VEGAS PHOENIX

For President Ford - a quick trip today to Las Vegas - where he addressed the national association of realtors. The President saying: "Somehow the word has gone out that the best way to beat inflation and revitalize the economy is to curtail buying. Nothing could be further from the truth", he went on. Adding: "Instead of curtailing purchases, I say to consumers simply - buy wisely - shop sharper."

The President also announced an allocation of three hundred million to help finance mortgages on existing homes. And he pledged that "despite economic weakness, recession, business fall-back - call it what you will - there will be an upturn in the nation's economy patterns."

The President then flew to Phoenix where he officially accepted delivery of the first of the Air Force new F-15 fighters. And tonight in Phoenix the President is addressing a meeting of professional journalists.

WHITE HOUSE
