In Vietnam -- rocket-firing American helicopters tonight attacked a force of Communist infiltrators -- within five miles of Saigon. U.S. rockets, flares and tracer bullets -- lighting up the sky in a display of fireworks -- clearly visible from rooftops in the city.

KASHMIR

We hear of another clash between Indian and Pakistani forces today in the Sind Desert area. India further daiming that Pakistani infiltrators -- are burning bridges and houses, as they fall back to their own lines, to the north in Kashmir.

Meanwhile, Pakistan today declared at the United Nations
that it will never withdraw from Kashmir unless a U.N.

Peace Force is present -- or there is some other machinery
to prevent India from moving in.

In Cairo -- Premier Ali Sabry of Egypt -- handed in his resignation today, to clear the way for the socalled "New Revolutionary Drive" -- demanded six months ago by Nasser.

The resignation expected to herald a top-to-bottom shake-up -- in the Arab Socialist Union -- Egypts only legal political party -- and in the government; but not in the field of foreign policy.
