President Kennedy stressed three points at today's news conference:-

First - the nuclear Test Ban Treaty, which he again strongly defended, for reasons we've already heard. This time with emphasis on our being ready to go back to testing if the Soviet Union violates the agreement.

Second - Foreign Aid, which the President made the subject of his opening statement. His purpose to prod the House to get on with the Administration Bill. Mr. Kennedy termed foreign aid - a key to our fight against Communism. "Necessary and essential" - was the way he put it.

Third - Civil Rights, which the President considers the number one crisis before the nation.

As for the march - on Washington. He's prepared to meet - the leaders o the march.
