


A New Era

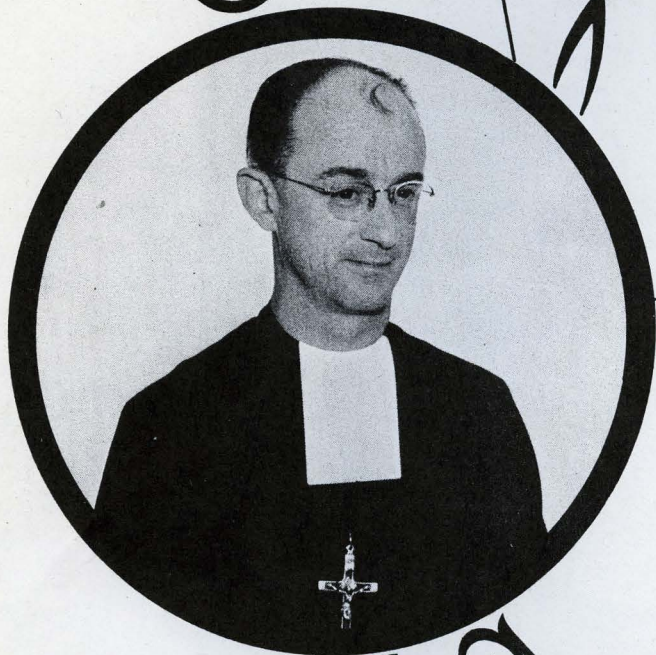

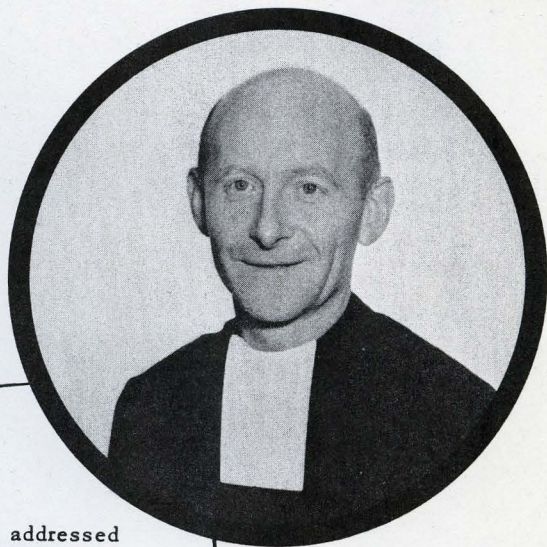

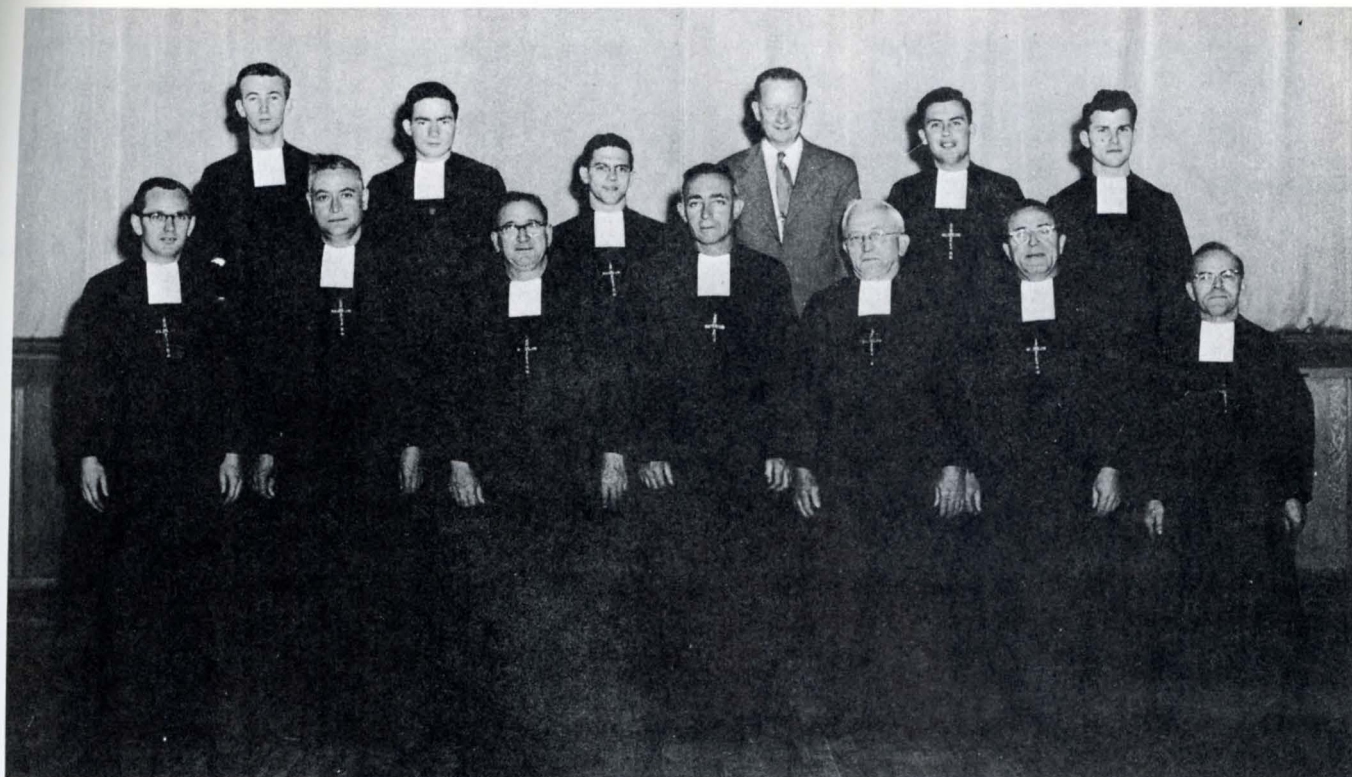

While dedicating this annual to you, Bro. Master, we pray that God may continue to grace future classes with your direction and example.



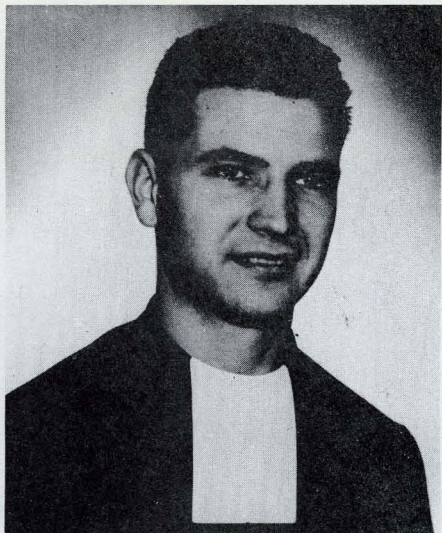

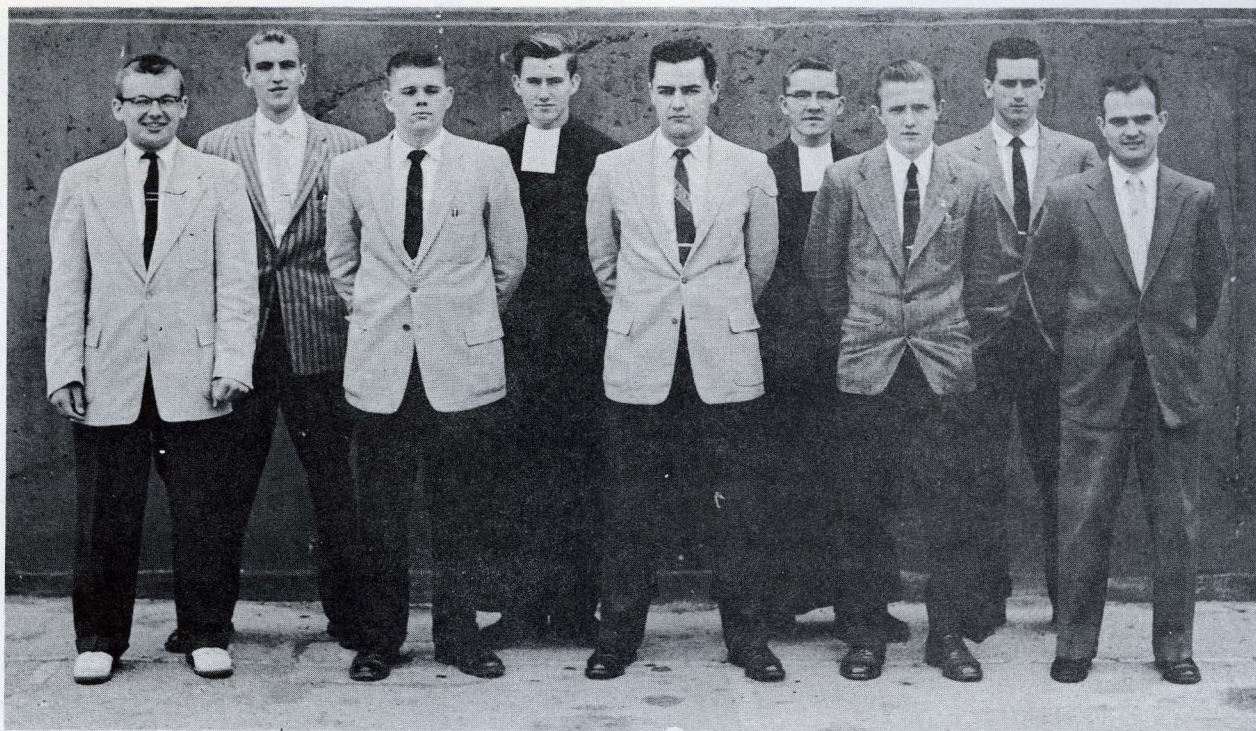

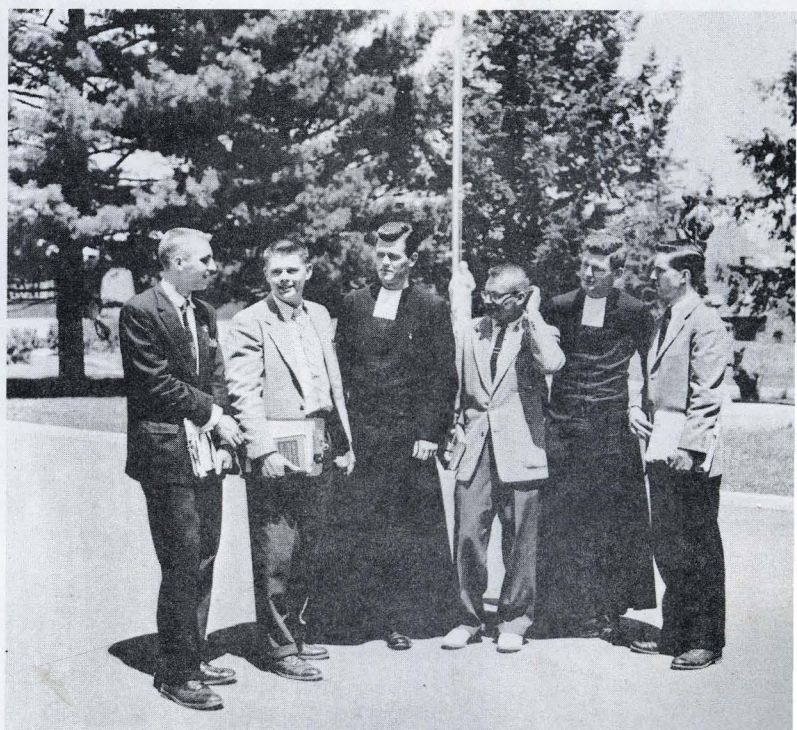

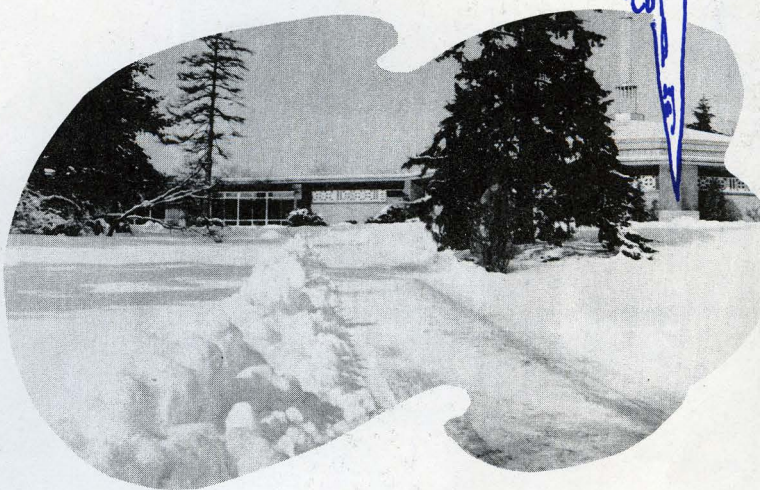

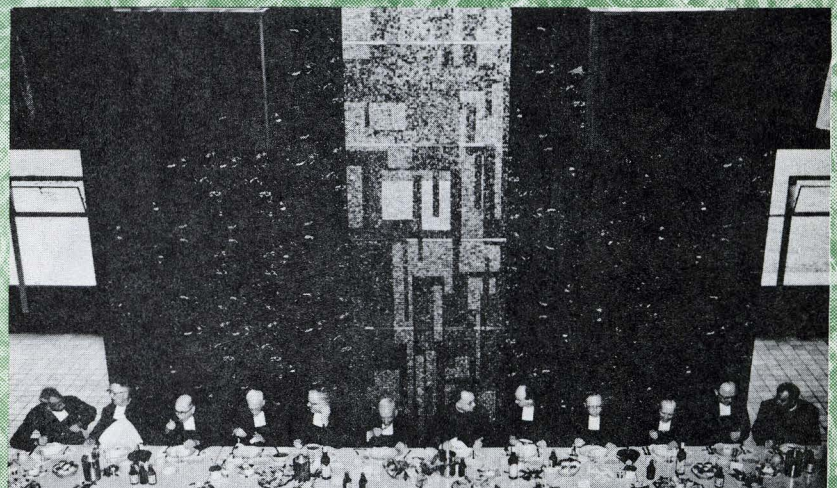

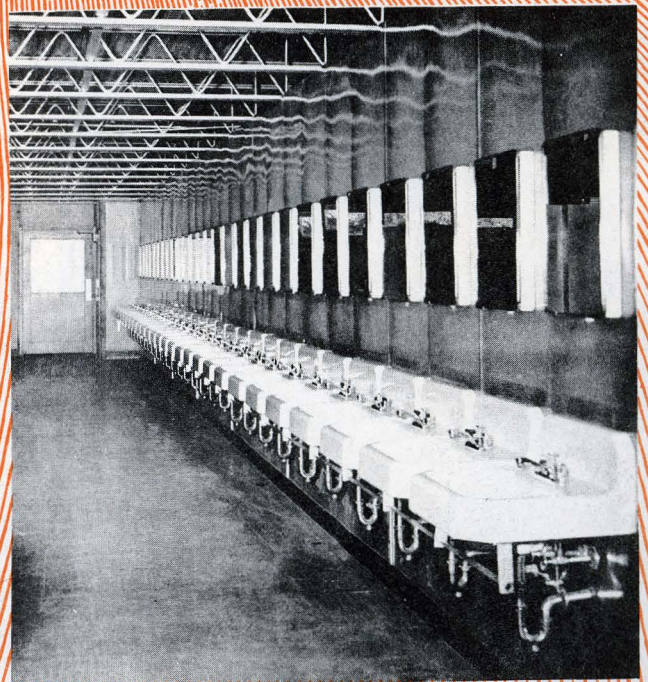
