One of my reasons for coming north to Canada was to take part in a ceremony, in which I happened to be interested: -- the opening up of the north side of the highest mountain in Eastern Canada, and the celebration of the tenth anniversary of the coming of a young man from the states to this rather remote region high up in the Laurentian Mountains.

Exactly ten years ago Joe Ryan, one of the numerous nephews of the legendary Thomas Fortune Ryan, was in these parts, traveling through the wilderness with Indian guides. We all met at Gray Rocks, long famous as a rendezvous for sportsmen. In the distance we could see Mont Tremblant, that highest mountain; but, to get there through the deep snow - not so easy.

However, one day in Tom Wheeler's small plane we flew round the mountain and then landed on a lake at the foot of it.

Through snow up to our waist we made our way up to the summit. It was a bright sunny day. The top of the mountain was covered with rime ice, the trees deep in power snow, with the lakes, and mountains of the Laurentians spread out before us.

Young Joe Ryan was impressed by the scene, and the mountain. Said he:- This surely is one of the most glorious spots in the world, and there's only one thing wrong, with it. It's too difficult getting up here." And Then, he added:- "I believe I'll fix that."

Which we all took as a joking remark, never dreaming he actually would do that and a lot more.
However, with incredible determination, and surmounting
plenty of obstacles, he set out to make this mountain
one of the most famous all-year-round recreation
centers in the world.

To a banquet in celebration of this tenth anniversary, and, to take part in the opening of the north side of the Mountain -- the Devil's River Country

representatives of the government have come from Ottawa.

Also representatives of the Provencial Government of

Quebec, from Montreal. The two principal speakers being

Bominion Senator Norman Paterson, and, one of the heads

of the Conservative Party, the Honorable Onesime Gagnon.

themselves in these mountains. He told us that the main
way of making a living then, was at a type of work which
as he put it, was, "too low for human beings."

Priest told us. And he said it was the first time he had
ever publicly expressed himself so fully about the
achievements of the young man from Philadelphia.
