While the Deep South traditionally goes Democratic, Barry Goldwater is making it clear that he expects a switch in November.

Later, in St. Petersburg, Florida -- the G. O. P. standard bearer concentrated on the Supreme Court. Charing that more of the rulings handed down by our highest tribunal, infringe on the liberties of the citizen.
