Now located in Syracuse, the I.R.A. was held on the Hudson from 1885-1948. Rowing returned to the river on a large-scale with the formation of the Marist crew in 1961, now under the direction of present coach Bill Austin.

This traditional event, which takes place the last weekend of April every spring, honors Dr. Linus Foy, President of Marist College. Dr. Foy's interest in the sport was instrumental in bringing crew back to the "regatta row."

The festivities begin Friday evening with the sixth annual President's Cup Banquet for all competing crews and friends of Marist rowing.

Last year saw the postponement of the Regatta until Sunday morning, and this was due to unusually rough water and high winds. This was the first time in Regatta history that the race was unable to be run when scheduled. The Regatta Committee hopes the river will cooperate and provide a great day for racing.

The entire squad comes off victories in all races last weekend and hopes to continue their winning ways. The heavyweights are undefeated and are looking for their first varsity victory in Regatta history. The lightweights had a very impressive victory last weekend over undefeated LaSalle College of Philadelphia. The freshman heavyweights defeated Temple and LaSalle's junior varsity with a beautiful finish. The oarsmen and coaches have set a goal to try to sweep the river on Saturday.

This will be the opening race for the women, and they will be competing against two opponents, one from Holy Cross and one from Rhode Island. Competing colleges in this year's Regatta are Holy Cross, Maritime College, Manhattan, Rhode Island, Fordham, Iona, and Villanova.

HERBERT J. HAIGHT POINT TROPHY
