But more than that - the President delivering ^{ed} a hard hitting speech, ~~lashing~~ lashing out at those he called ~~the~~ "new insolationists." Those, ~~he~~ said he, ~~who~~ would "tell us - as predecessors in other times have told us - that the appetite for ~~aggression~~ aggression can be satisfied if only we are patient;" that "the ambitions of the aggressor are justified, ~~if~~ if only we understand them properly."

It's that kind of thinking - that has led to American's having to fight in four wars in this century - said the President. And he added: "I am never surprised to hear these positions held - but I am always astonished to hear them held in the name of morality."

WILLIAMSBURG

Chief Justice Warren Burger - the chief speaker today
at that national judicial conference - Williamsburg, Virginia,
~~where~~ ^{he} ~~suggested~~ ^{ed} the establishment of a new central agency -
to undertake a "comprehensive ~~examination~~ examination" of state courts.
~~Justice Burger asserting that~~ ^{saying} such an agency is "desperately
needed" - to help the state court's ~~to~~ dispense justice more
fairly and more quickly.

INDO CHINA

In the war news tonight - a strategic withdrawal from the newly occupied village of Sepone in Laos. ~~The~~ U S helicopters evacuating more than a thousand South Vietnamese troops ~~in~~ in the face of an advancing enemy force estimated in the many thousands. A South[^]vietnamese official explaining: "We are using the air mobility tactic of moving our forces around - rather than keeping them in fixed positions." And he might have added - no one wants to risk another Dien Bien Phu.

NEW DELHI

Indira Gandhi's tremendous election victory continued to

mount today. The ^{tiny} lady Prime Minister claiming at last report -

and twenty more than three hundred seats in the new ~~Indian~~ Indian

parliament. Madame Gandhi's new congress party candidates -

also leading in ~~more than half~~ ^{many} of the ~~hundred~~ ^{ninety} or so ~~places~~ ^{contests}

still to be decided. And this is said to mean a sure two-

thirds majority - more than three hundred and forty-seven

votes; enough even to change the constitution - to change

the future course of ~~the~~ India.

ANKARA

In Turkey in the face of mounting leftist violence -
an armed forces ultimatum today. Turkish military leaders
threatening to take over the country - unless the resignation
of ~~the~~ Premier Suleyman Demirel was tendered immediately;
whereupon - it was. Demirel remaining to head a care-taker
government though ~~at least~~^{until} till the appointment of his
successor.

BELFAST

At Belfast in Northern Ireland - a remarkable display of public unity; with a crowd of about seven thousand protestant and Roman Catholic shipyard workers - staging a mass march today. The demonstrators urging tough action - to combat the threats of extremist gunmen; specifically ~~in~~ urging the introduction of internment without ~~submit~~ trial - also, the rearming of police. A spokesman for the workers saying: "All shades of opinion are on the march today."

Meanwhile, the government of Northern Ireland was calling in Scotland Yard - to investigate the killing of those three British soldiers. At the same time, Britain alerting an additional three thousand troops - against the possibility of ~~new~~ renewed violence.

SALT LAKE CITY

At Salt Lake City - the death of one of America's greatest inventors of all time. Philo T. Farnsworth -- *who* at age fifteen ~~the~~ developed ^d a complete theory of electronic television. At age eighteen - applying for a patent on his first complete televisinn system. At age twenty - after he was forced to drop out of college for lack of funds - transmitting the world's first television picture.

That was back in Nineteen Twenty Seven. In the years since -- Farnsworth obtaining more than three hundred American and foreign electronic patents. And ~~but~~ he was still going strong - right up to the end. Philo T. Farnsworth - age sixty-four.
