THE NEW CONGRESS, TODAY, VOTED - AN EXTRAORDINARY JOINT SESSION ON SATURDAY. TO HEAR PRESIDENT EISENHOWER EXPLAIN HIS PROGRAM FOR BLOCKING RED AGGRESSION IN THE MIDDLE EAST. HE WILL ASK FOR A CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FOUR HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS -IN ECONOMIC AID. ALSO - FOR THE USE OF AMERICAN ARMED FORCE, IF NECESSARY.

IT'S A RARE THING FOR CONGRESS TO HOLD A SESSION ON SATURDAY. PARTICULARLY - A MERE TWO DAYS AFTER A NEW CONGRESS CONVENES. BUT THE DOMINANT THEME IN INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS, RIGHT NOW - IS THAT "EISENHOWER DOCTRINE."

PROMPTLY, TODAY - THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE GOT ORGANIZED. ROUTINE IN THE HOUSE - WHERE THE DEMOCRATIC MAJORITY IS AMPLE. NO QUESTION -ABOUT SAM RAYBURN OF TEXAS BEING THE NEW SPEAKER. SEVENTY-FIVE YEAR OLD MR. SAM - HOLDING THAT OFFICE LONGER THAN ANYBODY ELSE IN THE HISTORY OF CONGRESS. THIS - HIS EIGHTH TERM.

BUT THE ORGANIZATION OF THE SENATE HAD AN ELEMENT - OF SUSPENSE. HOW WOULD LAUSCHE OF OHIO VOTE.. A NEW DEMOCRATIC SENATOR - AND HE'S A MAVERICK. HE HAD RAISED SOME SURMISE - THAT HE MIGHT VOTE

WITH THE GOP. ENABLING THE REPUBLICANS - TO ORGANIZE THE SENATE. THE DEMOCRATIC MARGIN - THAT SLIM. The NEW SENATOR HANSCHE KEPT UP THE SUSPENSE UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE. NEVER SAYING - HOW HE WOULD VOTE, UNTIL HIS NAME WAS CALLED. THEN HE VOTED, - ON THE SIDE OF THE DEMOCRATS. ENABLING THEM TO ORGANIZE THE SENATE - WITH THEIR HAIR-LINE MAJORITY OF TWO. FORTY-NINE DEMOCRATS - FORTY SEVEN REPUBLICANS.

AFTER WHICH - THE SENATE WAS CONFRONTED IMMEDIATELY WITH ITS BIG FIGHT. SAME OLD ISSUE - CIVIL RIGHTS. A FACTION OF LIBERAL DEMOCRATS - PUTTING UP A BATTLE TO CHECK THE OLD BUSINESS OF SOUTHERN FILIBUSTERS. THE WAY THE DIXIELAND SENATORS HAVE - OF TALKING THE RACIAL RIGHTS BILL TO DEATH.

ANDERSON OF NEW MEXICO LED OFF, AS LEADER OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS FORCES. INTRODUCING A MOTION - FOR THE ADOPTION OF NEW SENATE RULES. WHICH - WOULD BLOCK FILIBUSTERS.

BUT THE DEMOCRATIC LEADER, LYNDON JOHNSON OF TEXAS, COUNTERED WITH A PROPOSAL - TO TABLE THE MOTION, KILL IT. WHEREUPON THE SENATE AGREED UNANIMOUSLY - TO VOTE ON THAT ISSUE TOMORROW TSIX PM STANDARD TIME. SIX HOURS WERE SET FOR DEBATE - SO THE BATTLE WILL NOT BE PROLONGED. THE BELIEF IS THAT THE MOTION FOR CHANGE OF RULES WILL BE DEFEATED. ANTI-FILIBUSTER EFFORTS - LOSING OUT.

ALL OF WHICH WAS A LOT OF BUSINESS FOR THE OPENING DAY OF THE NEW SESSION OF CONGRESS. THE USUAL THING - NOTHING MORE THAN A. LOT OF POLITE FORMALITIES. WHICH FORMALITIES, OF COURSE, WERE ENACTED - WITH AN EXTRA DOSE OF POLITENESS, TODAY.

IN THE VISITORS GALLERY OF THE SENATE - ADLAI STEVENSON. LOSER IN THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION. STEVENSON, TODAY, RECEIVING - A STANDING OVATION FROM REPUBLICANS AS WELL AS DEMOCRATS. WITH A POLITE BOW, A COURTLY BOW - FROM VICE PRESIDENT NIXON, AS HE PRESIDED OVER THE SENATE PROCEEDINGS. NIXON SAID - HE WAS "CERTAINLY MOST HAPPY TO WELCOME" STEVENSON. AND REGRETTED THAT THE RULES OF THE SENATE WOULD NOT PERMIT A VISITOR TO MAKE A SPEECH. SO, ALAS, THE SENATORS COULD NOT , IN DICK NIXON'S WORDS "ENJOY THE ELOQUENCE FOR WHICH HE (STEVENSON) IS FAMOUS."

WHICH COURTESY WAS ALL IN ACCORDANCE - WITH SENATORIAL TRADITION.

THE OPENING OF CONGRESS - A TRADITIONAL DAY OF CHURCH GOING. PRESIDENT EISENHOWER, TOGETHER WITH CABINET MEMBERS, LEADERS OF CONGRESS, AND SUPREME COURT JUSTICES - ATTENDING PRAYER AND HOLY COMMUNION SERVICE AT THE NATIONAL PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH. THE PRESIDENT - RECEIVING COMMUNION FROM THE PRESBYTERIAN ELDER, A NAME JOHN FOSTER DULLES, SECRETARY OF STATE. U. N

CONCIAN AND CARACTERS.

THE U.N. HAS REJECTED AN ENDEAVOR - TO INVITE COMMUNIST NORTH KOREA TO A DEBATE ON THE KOREAN QUESTION. THE POLITICAL COMMITTEE -TURNING DOWN A RESOLUTION BACKED BY SOVIET RUSSIA AND INDIA. NO NEW "SUMMIT CONFERENCE."

WINDS - AT SEVENTY-FIVE MILES AN HOUR. TEMPERATURE - THIRTY-ONE DEGREES BELOW ZERO. RESCUE ATTEMPS - IMPOSSIBLE FOR NINE DAYS.

THEN, NEW YEARS EVE, RESCUE BY HELICOPTER SEEMEDPROSSIBLE. BUT A HELICOPTER, WITH FOUR RESCUERS ABOARD, WAS WRECKED ON A LOFTY PLATEAU. SOME DISTANCE FROM THE TWO MARGONED CLIMBERS.

ANOTHER HELICOPTER WITH FOUR ABOARD - GOING TO THE RESCUE. BUT, IT ALSO, WAS FORCED DOWN - AND THERE WERE EIGHT STRANDED RESCUERS.

SO THAT WAS THE SITUATION, TODAY - WHEN OTHER HELICOPTER ATTEMPTS WERE MADE. SUCCESSFUL ENOUGH - TO TAKE OUT THOSE EIGHT MAROONED MEN FROM THE HIGH PLATEAU. BUT WHAT ABOUT THE TWO ORIGINAL CLIMBERS. THAT QUESTION WAS ANSWERED BY THE FRENCH AIR MINISTER, DIRECTING THE RESCUE OPERATIONS. HE SAID - THAT, IN THE BAD WEATHER, NO FURTHER HELICOPTER EFFORTS COULD BE MADE. IMPOSSIBLE - TO REACH THE PLACE WHERE THE TWO LAY, AMID ICY CRAGS. MOREOVER, SAID THE AIR MINISTER, IT WAS "IMPROBABLE" THAT THEY STILL SURVIVED.' HELICOPTER PILOTS REPORTED - NO SIGNS OF LIFE. SO IT WOULD BE FUTILE TO RISK OTHER LIVES.

BUT A SWISS MOUNTAIN FLYER, HERMAN GEIGER, OFFERED TO MAKE A FINAL ATTEMPT, IN A SKI PLANE. HOPING TO MAKE A LANDING ON THE GLACIER, AND SEE WHAT HE COULD DO.

AS HARD A DECISION - AS PARENTS EVER HAD TO MAKE. . BOB HAWKEY, NEWS EDITOR OF WJNO, THE VOICE OF CBS IN THE PALM BEACHES, HAS JUST GIVEN ME A COLORFUL ITEM, ABOUT AN OLD FRIEND OF MINE, CHARLES FRANCIS COE, BETTER KNOWN AS SOCKER COE.
