See Parly today, Kassem's Baghdad radio announced - rebellion crushed. Shawaf - killed by his own men. Which report - incited huge demonstrations in Baghdad, supporting the leftist regime.

Stating - the rebit rebellion had spread all over northern

Iraq. Shawaf's voice on the radio - denying the report that

he had been killed. And - bitterly denouncing Kassem as a

traitor. Later By hadd broadcast - that Shawaf had been killed

arrested.

The Kassem air force bombarded Mosul, rebel headquarters. That ancient city - which is a key point in the great oilfields of northern Iraq. The insurgents announcing - they were advancing on the re ground. Launching - a march on Baghdad.

One point of speculation - the character of the Mosul radio. The rak rebels - broadcasting with a powerful transmitter. While it is known - that the regular Mosul station is a small one, with only weak facilities for broadcasting.

Hence the supposition - that the alleged Mosul radio may really be a powerful station in Syria, Nasser's Arab

Republic. The revolt being - anti-Communist and pro-Nasser.

But, on the other hand, there a surmise a that the insurgents at Mosul are broadcasting with a powerful mobile transmitter, military equipment.

Another angle of radio - a broadcast from a city

two hundred miles east of Mosul. Supporting the insurgent

regime. Which would indicate - a spread of the revolt.

One thing is clear - it's all a military affair,

a do feud in the Iraq army. Shawaf, at Mosul, has a powerful

force - largely armored. Capable - of striking quickly across
the ground. In Baghdad, Kassem seems in full control - but
there's doubt about the fidelity of his army units. Possible
anti-Communist elements - among them.

International reverberations? Of course. The

Moscow radio immediately charging # that the revolt in Iraq

was decided by the United States. The Americans - trying to

topple the left wing regime at one of the great oil centers

of this earth. Iraq - producing one-sixth of the world's

petroleum. The all-important pipelines windisturbed thus far.

More concessions - offered by Khrushchev. Who, today, suggested that if Berlin be made a "free city" the troops of the western allies might remain. Taking the view, that American, British, French and Russian soldiers could be kept in Berlin, as they are now. To guarantee the independence of the "free city", as Khrushchev put it. Which is much in contrast to the previous Moscow stand - that the western military forces would have to leave.

Today, Khrushchev also stated that the East German Reds would guarantee western communications with Berlin. When - the Communist regime ** takes over the Russian control of the entire eastern zone.

Khrushchev made these declarations, addressing a mass meeting in communist East Orm Berlin. Last week, he made a concession - when he said the deadline might be extended for a couple of months.

In Washington, high diplomatic officials reply that

he are not interested in the Khrushchev concessions.

a Nazi governor, was not responsible for the atrocities in
the concentration camps.

Today - found guilty. The capital sentence - pronounced.

Things are shaping up, apparently, - for a full scale court battle over one of America's historic fortunes.

The Astor millions. Today, John Jacob Astor, third, asked for an investigation of the will left by his half-brother, Vincent Astor.

It all traces back to Colonel John Jacob Astor,
who perished in the sinking of the Titanic, back in Nineteen
Twelve. His son by his second wife, John Jacob Astor,
Third - born several months after his father's death. Colonel
Astor's will leaving the huge Astor funtume to Vincent Astor,
his son by his first wife. No mention - of the child not yet
born.

In the settlement, however, John Jacob Astor Third got something. Today - rated as a wealthy man.

As time went by - little love lost between the two half-brothers. Vincent Astor - serious, with earnest views about the use me to which the Astor fortune should be put.

John Jacob Astor, Third - involved in a series of matrimonial entanglements. Right now, there's a dispute about who really is his legal wife.

Vincent Astor left no children. His will, assigning two million dollars to his widow. Sundry bequests of more than eight hundred thousand dollars. The bulk of the great fortune - going to the philanthropic Vincent Astor Foundation. No mention - of John Jacob Astor Third, Whose

contention is that his father, if he had known, would have willed a large part of his millions to his unborn son. Who never got his proper share of the estate.

At Poughkeepsie, New York, today he launched an investigation of the Vincent Astor will. To consider the possibility - of undue influence. Even - fraud and forgery.
