plane -- for a flight to Vancouver for joint ceremonies

concerning -- international exploitation of the

Columbia River. A power complex -- that will

produce electricity for both Canada and the United

States.

After that, the President and the Prime

Minister on to Blaine, Washington, for more

formalities -- at the International Paace Arch. Then their farewells to one another, with Prime Minister Pearson -- heading back for Ottawa. President Johnson -- on to Seattle.
