*From the Japanese government a decision today to give in to the Japanese Red Army terrorists - who shot their way into the U.S. Embassy in Kuala Lumpur, Malaya. A Tokyo spokesman noting the terrorists are holding about fifty hostages - including U.S. Consul Robert Stebbins and four other Americans. Tokyo saying: "Priority must be given - to the protection of lives."*

*They did run into a problem with two of the prisoners in Japan not wanting to be released. But five are now being flown to Kuala Lumpur.*
