Wallace also saying: "I have no master plan - but I do want to stay in the Democratic party." Meanwhile, Hubert Humphrey was ruling out another possible bid for the Vice Presidency. "I have been a Vice President" - said Humphrey. Further observing: "It is an interesting job - and someone who has not had the experience should get it." Said he: "It builds character."
