In Red hungary, Budapest, Joseph Cardinal Mindszenty, the Primate of Hungary, went on trial today. In court a letter he mate wrote was read. a letter in which the Cardinal estated:-"I have recognized that I hag have committed in principle the crimes charged against me." These crimes consist of -acts against the San men Communist Dictatorship. The Cardinal is accused of plotting with Americans and British against the Red regime - he being in favor of restoration of the ancient monarchy in llungery. In court, today, when the letter was read, Cardinal Mindszenty was asked - had he written it? He walked to a microphone and said " $^{\text {yes. The are }}$ told that the Primate of Hungary has made an offer to help in promoting peace between the Red puppet government and the Hungarian Church, over which he presides. He is represented as asking that his trial be delayed for this purpose. Request denied - trial (defendants, continuing. Six other (azumexity coworkers of the Cardinal, faced the Red tribunal today - in a court room guarded as only the Reds can guard. Soldiers
armed with tommy guns stationed a few paces apart and each defendant guarded by a Red policeman, who sits mix behind him. Such is the scene as the Hungarian Reds proceed against the first Cardinal of the roman Churchy to be placed on trial in modern times.

In Vienna, the American zone, statement was made today by the leader of the Hungarian Democratic Peoples Party - the only remaining group in opposition to the dictatorship. He is ant fugitive, arriving in Vienna after flight from Hungary.

Today he stated that he got out to escape the na vengeance of the Reds, because he would iata not join in denouncing Cardinal Mindszenty and the Vatican. This the Reds wanted him to do - wanted that one remaining non-Comunistic party to add its voice to the Red chorus against the prelate on trial and the Roman -Catholic church. Refusal meant reprisals, so the leader of the Peoples Party got outf - managed to escape.

## ADD HUNGARY

The Cardinal was subjected to more than
five hours of questioning, during which he denied
sa taking part in any plot, but admitted his opposition to the Reds.

UNIONS
In washington - a proposition that congress
ale it a crime for communists to hold office in a labor union. This is suggested by the Secretary of Labor, Morris Robin, who ap pared before a Bang Congressional Committee today.

The committee is considering the repealof the Iaft-artley hgt and Secretary Robin decried the non-comanist affidavit provision of that labor law. He said it was no good- that clause of the TaftHartley law which requires that labor union officials take an oath that they are not Comanits. This does not keep Reds an from controlling unions, declared the Secretary of tabor; and he demanded something far more severe - make it a criminal offense et for
a Communist to be union official.

From Oak Ridge, Tennessee, a statement - that this country must press the development of an atomic airplane engine. This comes from Brigadier General 1.A. Sims, head of an atomic engine project.

He points out that atomic bombs are of little use, unless we have some way to carry the to a target - distant target. In an minciaze up-to-date sense this means - jet planes.

But the jets, at present, have little rage. General bias points out that at supersonic. speed, it requires eight thousand pounds of fuel to fly two and one half minutes. Which would make a supersonic jet flight of ten thousand miles a fantastic impossibility. But the atomic power derived from one pound of uranium is equivalent to two million da gallons of gasoline. So the atonic possibilities in point of distance, are virtually endless. General Sims thinks that the pane in which an atomic engine will be used is likely to be - the flying wing type. In the flying wing, the atom mic engine might be placed in the middle, with the

quarters for the crews at the ends of the wing. Which Eh n would keep the crew away from the immediate area of atomic radiation.

He tells me that he feeds his own private stock of worms with a special kind of diet. He gives them cornmeal mixed with coffee grounds. That latter item, coffee grounds, surprised me no end.
