**GOOD EVENING EVERYBODY:**

*You probably have heard how after thirteen hours of terror all of the Arabs guerrillas were killed or captured. The hostages? - safe.*

*The Olympic Games to resume tomorrow. But they'll hardly be the same.*

*You no doubt have followed the story today of how the guerrillas invaded the Israeli quarters in Olympic Village; killing two Israelis - and seizing eight others as hostages; threatening a mass execution - if their demands were not met; said demands including - number one - the release of some two hundred Arab terrorists now held in Israeli prisons. All this - touching off a worldwide furore also forcing a cancellation - of today's Olympic competition. With hundreds of West German police completely surrounding the area while from West German Chancellor Willie Brandt who flew to the scene - a nationwide address. Brandt saying his government had tried "everything" to win freedom*

**for the hostages - "but everything was rejected."**

**Now the terror is over - the Israeli athletes  
and coaches safe. The guerrillas dead or captured.**

## **HARRISBURG**

*Harrisburg, Pennsylvania - anti war priest Philip Berrigan was sentenced today - to an additional two years in prison; for smuggling letters out of the federal penitentiary at Lewisburg, Pennsylvania - where he was already serving a six years sentence.*

*Sister Elizabeth McAleister - a Roman Catholic ~~Nun~~ Nun also sentenced to one year in the same case.*

**SAN CLEMENTE**

*From the Western White House at San*

*Clemente* <sup>*may*</sup> <sub>^</sub> an announcement ~~today~~ that Henry Kissinger will soon be off again. <sub>^</sub> The President's chief foreign policy advisor flying first to Munich for two days of talks with West German officials; and then ~~fly~~ on to Moscow for three days ~~of talks~~ with Kremlin leaders. The White House adding only that <sup>*Dr.*</sup> Kissinger will discuss "matters of mutual interest."

**PRESIDENT**

*San Clemente again - the President today urged Congress - to put aside partisan ~~politics~~ politics; to enact at last his ~~long-ending~~ proposals for improving the environment. Each day of inaction - said he - "sees more of our land despoiled - our water further polluted, noise levels mounting - and harmful substances spreading throughout the environment."*

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## SAN FRANCISCO

*The President later flying to San Francisco for a brief stop enroute to Washington. This billed as "non-political." While there he viewed "Gateway West" on San Francisco Bay - a twenty-two mile stretch of land he hopes will be made into a major park. This one of the stalled projects he referred to earlier.*

SEATTLE PORTLAND ~~follow~~ *President*

On the Democratic side - ~~George~~ <sup>Sen.</sup> McGovern

was campaigning today through the Pacific Northwest.

At Seattle the home of Boeing aircraft - touring a warehouse that supplies food to the city's unemployed.

Also calling for a crash program - to build quieter jet engines; a program said he - that could provide twenty five thousand jobs - almost over night. And later on -

a trip to Portland; where the Democratic nominee toured a suburban retirement center; There <sup>he</sup> ~~called~~ <sup>ed</sup> for a vast expansion of Social Security benefits; "At a net cost of only three billion from general revenues," said he.

<sup>he added</sup>  
"social security," would not provide complete coverage for aged, blind and disabled Americans; with a ~~max~~ minimum monthly payment of one hundred and fifty dollars."

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## HILTON HEAD ISLAND

*Across the continent - at Hilton Head Island - South Carolina - at the Southern Governors Conference, Governor Wallace of Alabama - was again holding center stage, observing that Senator McGovern - does have a pretty liberal posture; also, pledging to "take a position" on the Presidential race - "within a few weeks." "Of course" he added - "that position might be - that I won't take a position." Next question - is Wallace himself - still interested in running for President? To which the Governor replied: "If my health is good in Seventy-Six - I will be interested."*



## BULL ISLAND

*In the aftermath of that giant rock festival  
at Bull Island in Illinois - death calls the tune. Police <sup>today</sup>  
turning up ~~today~~ two bodies. One, that of a young  
man - apparently the victim of an overdose of heroin;  
and the other - a victim of quote "natural" causes.*

NASU

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At his summer villa at Nasu in the Japanese Alps, Emperor Hirohito of Japan ~~held~~ today <sup>held</sup> a rare press conference. Rarer still, casting aside his public reserve; stating publicly - that he would like to visit the United States.

This in response to a question - about the invitation he received last week from President Nixon. The Emperor observing: "America is our neighboring country across the Pacific". Adding: "In addition to visiting Europe for purposes of good ~~will~~ will I should visit America, too." And, so the trip will probably be made ~~we are told~~ some time around the middle of next year.

Europe the Republic of India is often called - simply

Indian Airlines official L. F. Cabral -

<sup>Modern version of Hinduism;</sup>  
~~of the Hindu~~ ~~Protestant~~; that the commander of  
India's fleet in the Arabian Sea - is a Christian; ~~that~~  
the commander of Indian troops on the Eastern front ~~is~~  
a turbaned, ~~and~~ bearded Sikh; that the commander of India's  
Agra air base is ~~actually~~ a Moslem.

Cabral further observing; "with so many  
Gods on our side how could we miss winning any wars?"

## VIRUNGA VOLCANO

Monkey, see, monkey do -- so the <sup>old</sup> saying  
goes ~~that~~ ~~but~~ now a reverse twist, - reported ~~today~~ from  
the Virunga Volcano country in Central Africa; where  
a team of British ~~and~~ anthropologists - has just devised

*Stranger than fiction is this next from the U S Navy research and development center in Hawaii. It's a report that Naval under-sea experts have successfully trained whales as under water retrievers. This by rewarding the whales with small fish; just as at aquarium they train porpoises. This all fully documented in a five minute movie - showing a pilot whale recovering a dummy torpedo.*

*Officials add that the great aquatic mammals - have made routine retrievals at depths of a thousand feet, while carrying recovery hardware to a maximum of more than sixteen hundred feet. A whale of a story?*
