Signals

By arrangement with the Pains-Manhattan Beach Fireworks Company of
19 Park Place, New York, the following signals will be given
from a point near the finish line:

The Start of each race will be indicated by one bomb.

A Re-call will be indicated by two bombs.

A Postponement of the regatta will be indicated by ten bombs.

The leading crew at each mile point, including the finish, will be indicated by bombs, the

number of which will correspond with the course number of the crew as stated on pages 1, 3 and 5 of this program.

The order of the crews at the finish will be indicated by their university colors suspended from the middle span of the bridge, the upper colors indicating the winner.

University Colors

COLUMBIA.....	Light Blue and White
CORNELL.....	Red and White
PENNSYLVANIA.....	Red and Dark Blue
SYRACUSE	Orange

The order and official times of the crews at the finish of each race will be announced by megaphone from the operating car in the middle of the observation train.
