end of the "Warren Era" in American jurisprudence; *This*  
with the ~~the~~ swearing-in of Warren Berger as new Chief  
Justice of the Supreme Court.

*1/2*  
President Nixon setting the tenor of the  
ceremony in a precedent setting - ~~the~~ "farewell address"  
to the retiring Chief Justice. Praising Earl Warren -  
for his "dignity, example and fairness." Adding that,  
"this nation owes him a debt of gratitude" ~~for~~ for helping  
to "keep America on the path of continuity and change,  
which is so essential to our progress."

In response - the seventy-eight year old  
Warren - thanking the President warmly. Noting that  
the White House and the High Court are both required  
to speak "the last word in great governmental affairs -  
a very awesome responsibility." And one - said he -  
in which "we are guided only by the Constitution and  
our consciences."

***With that his last official act as Chief Justice, Earl Warren swearing in as his successor - the new man at the top. When it was all over - quietly announcing: "Ladies and gentlemen - the Chief Justice of the United States."***

***And so - the Berger Era begins.***

PENTAGON

*The first withdrawal of U S forces from Viet Nam - scheduled for July eighth - so announced today by the Pentagon. Which further identified the vanguard of returning troops - as the Third Battalion, Sixtieth Regiment, Ninth Infantry Division.*

*Nine hundred men in all - expected to*

*arrive by jet July ninth at McChord Air Force Base in the*

*State A They Washington. Next stop - Fort Lewis, near Tacoma,*

*~~Washington~~ where the men of the "Lucky Third" will be processed - either for discharge or new assignments.*

~~On the other side of the globe the~~  
~~battle of Ben Het enters a new phase.~~ <sup>P</sup> ~~with~~ <sup>Q</sup> a force  
of ~~about~~ <sup>some</sup> five hundred South Vietnamese infantrymen ~~were~~  
battling their way <sup>out Ben Het</sup> ~~from~~ ~~the~~ ~~camp~~ today; attempting  
to ~~try~~ reopen a supply line to nearby Dak To - and  
thereby break a siege that has now lasted forty-eight  
days. This following a pair of Viet Cong ground  
attacks - that were ~~being~~ beaten back with heavy  
casualties. However, the enemy <sup>seemed</sup> ~~is~~ far from finished  
with Ben Het. Communist gunners bombarding the  
camp for a twentieth straight day. ~~even as the~~  
~~relief action was begun.~~ ~~and~~ In spite of enemy ~~the~~  
losses set at fifteen hundred so far - another fifteen  
hundred Viet Cong are believed still in the area.

CAIRO TEL AVIV

In the Middle East - the pressure was building again today'; in the wake of another ~~exchange~~ <sup>set to</sup> ~~of sneak attacks~~ between Egyptian and ~~the~~ Israeli commandos. The first announced by Tel Aviv. A strike by Israeli commandos - into North Jordan. Followed quickly by an Egyptian raid across the Suez Canal. This, in turn - setting off a three hour artillery duel. According to U N observers - *this is an* ~~dangerous~~ escalation of an already tense situation.

## VATICAN
