On the Gulf coast of Texas - in and around
the resort city of Corpus Christi - gale winds, raging
tides and torrential rains today; heralding the advance
of hurricane Celia - the ^{potential} first "killer" hurricane to
hit the U S mainland in more than a year. The storm -
packing winds up to a hundred and forty miles an hour -
sending thousands of coastal residents and summer
tourists - fleeing inland.

DENVER

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For President Nixon - the end of an eleven day working vacation at the Western White House - followed today by a flight to Denver ^{where} ~~with~~ an airport crowd of ^{some} ~~about~~ three thousand - cheer^{ed} ~~ing~~ the President's arrival. Mr. Nixon telling the throng. "Rather than have the states and counties and the cities come to Washington - we are bringing Washington to the people, where it belongs."

The President then joining Attorney General John Mitchell - in a meeting with some two hundred law enforcement officials from all over the country. An attempt - said he - to help local communities in ^{their} ~~was~~ war against crime.

INDO CHINA

At the top of the war news tonight - a report of mounting U S air strikes in ~~some~~ Cambodia - with American jets said to be pounding Communist targets - both North and South of Phnom Penh. This - we are told - in support of a two-pronged Cambodian offensive; aimed - one, at ~~a city~~ securing the Capitol area - and two, reopening Phnom Penh's life line to the sea. All of which is denied, however \leftarrow by the U S command in Saigon.

PARIS FOLLOW INDO CHINA

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Meanwhile, U S Ambassador David Bruce, ^{WDA} arriving ~~today~~ in Paris, where he now becomes the chief U S Delegate - in Vietnam peace talks. Bruce telling newsmen - "the U S is desirous of seeing an end to the conflict!" ~~so~~ Adding that he expects to keep in close touch with President Nixon -" on the procedures and - hopefully, on the progress of these talks." The new Ambassador stressing, however, ^{that} he would make "no statement on Vietnamese affairs."

CAPE KENNEDY

For Secretary of State William Rogers -

This in an attempt to speed the ~~implem~~ implementation

MIDDLE EAST

However
~~In the meantime~~ Arab and Israeli dissidents -
were continuing to "make ~~any~~ waves" in the Middle East,
itself. This leading to talks today - between Egypt's
Colonel Nasser and Libya's Premier Al-Khadasy. The
latter then flying to Baghdad - in a bid to heal the
rift between Egypt and Iraq. While Israel's hawkish
Gahal Party - was trying to decide whether or not to
quit the Israeli government. In light of which - the
fighting still goes on. Israeli ~~jets~~ jets today hitting
Egyptian targets - for the seventy-fifth straight day.
according to ~~Cairo~~ ~~Cairo~~ ~~through~~ - the
Israeli's paying this time with a loss of two more planes.

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SENATE

From Chairman William Scranton of the President's commission on campus arrest - an announcement of planned hearings later this week in Los Angeles; the ~~purpose~~ panel's first such hearings - outside the nation's capitol.
