Word is - that Governor Lausche may have a fight on his hands. Backers of Senator Kefauver, we hear, will make a fight for their champion in the Ohio primaries. Although - Lausche, as has been proven over and over, is mighty popular there. Elected Governor for a record five times.

It isn't clear whether or not he'll try for state office again - while competing as the "Ohio favorite son". He might run for a sixth term as Governor. Or - for the Senate. Lausche, himself has remarked that he might like to be Senator from Ohio.

Nor is it clear how far Frank Lausche has any serious ambition for the White House. The "Favorite Son" position might really be meant - for wielding

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influence at the convention, Lausche might be a formidable contender for the Democratic nomination except for one thing - religion. He's a Catholic and everybody remembers the fate of Al Smith in Nineteen Twenty@Eight.

Governor Lausche himself, has laughed off presidential prospects for himself, saying - Ximpersix "impossible".
