UNITED NATIONS

At the United Nations - an attempt today by the Third World powers - to condemn South Africa for alleged interference in Angola. This leading to a blast from U.S. Ambassador ~~Dante~~ Moynihan -- at what he called "the big lie in Angola."

There are those who would have us believe - said he - there is "one nation and one nation only" intervening in Angola; when, in fact - he continued - the Soviet Union is the nation most heavily involved; "a new European colonial, imperialistic power" - waging an "armed, aggressive, direct assault on the lands and peoples of Africa." Moynihan ^{then} ~~concluded~~ ^{by} saying: "If this Assembly will not face this fact - then what is the good of this place!"

REINECKE

The conviction of former Lieutenant-Governor Reinecke of California for lying to a Senate committee - reversed today by a Court of Appeals in Washington. The higher court ruling that a quorum was not present - and the Senate committee, therefore, was not formally in session.

CAPITOL HILL

~~Capitol Hill again~~ The Senate today completed approval of a Forty-Five Billion-Dollar appropriation - for the Department of Health, Education and Welfare. This including a restriction on the use of Federal funds - to finance busing for purposes of racial integration. ~~However,~~ the amount of the appropriation - nearly a Billion more than recommended by the White House, and a veto - is considered likely.

BRUSSELS

At Brussels; - ^{at} a meeting of ten of the thirteen

European members of NATO, The so-called "Eurogroup" -

agreed ^d to finance a major strengthening of NATO forces -

over the next year. ^{with nine} ~~This to include the purchase of nine~~

new warships, - more than a hundred-and-fifty modern jet

fighters - and more than three hundred new tanks.

STOCKHOLM

The three American winners of this year's Nobel Prize in Medicine - in Stockholm today, ^{held} ~~holding~~ a joint news conference. Doctors David Baltimore, Howard Temin, and Renato Dulbecco saying about half of all cancer deaths - are due to environmental factors, ~~including~~ mainly smoking, ~~Adding that~~ ^{with} warnings apparently do ^{no} good, ~~"people still~~ ~~smoke"~~ - and the number of youngsters smoking ~~is~~ ^{is} appalling."
