In London - a group representing the combined economic might of the free world, the "group of ten"

- the ten richest nations this side of the Iron Curtain - arrived to discuss what to do about the world money crisis. The leadoff speaker - US Treasury Secretary John Connolly - told his fellow delegates how the $U S$ wants - and must have - a thirteen billion dollar turn about in foreign expenditures; including at least seven to eight billion - in the form of a trade surplus. He said this is a "conservative" estimate; one based on a "realistic" outlook - and not merely a bargaining ploy. Also that the $U$ S has no intention of devaluing the American dollar. Reaction? Well hear more tomorrow and next day.
