An Indian engineer living in West Berlin - says that he's going to knock down the Red Wall. Tapeshwar Zutshi, announcing the date - October second, Mahatma Gandhi's birthday. Tapeshwar Zutshi, writing to as fallows: -"I Tupeshwar Zutchi Ulbricht - Challenge you to shoot me, as you have shot so many refugees." Rounds as if there might be a hot time at the Red Wall - come October second. More Meanwhile, twenty-nine East Germans have escaped from East Berlin - in the biggest mass break for freedom, since the Wall went up. Their escape route - a tunnel under the Wall.
