U.N. - PROBABLE LEAD STORY

A MESSAGE FROM FRANCE TO THE UNITED NATIONS TODAY --
STAY OUT OF THE TUNISIAN DISPUTE.

A SHARPLY-WORDED STATEMENT - SAID TO HAVE BEEN
WRITTEN BY PRESIDENT DE GAULLE ^ DECLARES THAT FRANCE WILL
NOT PERMIT THE U.N. TO INTERVENE - THAT THE ONLY WAY THE
CRISIS CAN BE SETTLED IS THROUGH DIRECT FRANCO-TUNISIAN
NEGOTIATIONS.

THE STATEMENT ADDED THAT FRANCE WILL HOLD THE
NAVAL BASE AT BIZERTE AS LONG AS THERE'S A THREAT OF WORLD
WAR THREE.

LATER IN THE DAY, WHEN THE U.N. SECURITY COUNCIL
DID TAKE UP TUNISIAN CHARGES OF FRENCH AGGRESSION, THE
FRENCH DELGATION BOYCOTTED THE HEARINGS.

A FEW HOURS AFTER DE GAULLE'S MESSAGE WAS RELEASED -
ADLAI STEVENSON FLEW INTO PARIS - A DAY EARLY - AT DE GAULLE'S
SPECIFIC INVITATION.

OUR AMBASSADOR SAID AFTERWARD THAT HE'S BEEN
ASSURED THAT FRANCE HAS NO INTENTION OF QUITTING THE UN. -

CONGRESS

The House Armed Services Committee has followed its counter-part in the Senate - giving quick, and unanimous approval to President Kennedy's request to spend almost a billion dollars more for planes, ships and missiles.

The Committee also authorized the President to call up two hundred and fifty thousand reservists if needed. The full house will get this part of the bill on Monday - and the rules Committee will consider the money question on Tuesday.

In the upper House, the full Senate approved both measures after brief debate.
