In paying tribute not only to our war dead - but
also to those who perished in the recent Mayaguez affair
he said: "As long as there are law breakers in the world we must have the strength and the resolve to stand up for
what is right; it is the price we have always paid for being gree, it is the price we must be willing to pay in the future."

Memorial Day in Manila was marked today
by another round of talks - on the future of $U S$
bases in the Philippines. But later, $U$ and Philippine officials took part in a ceremony at the American war dead cemetery; Paying tribute to the more than fifty thousand Americans and Filipinos who died fighting side by side in World War Two. This including a statement from President

Marcos, ${ }^{\text {a former Japanese } P O W \text {, }}$ to the effect that: "America, the land of the freemust not begrudge other nations a similar ambition."
